Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to M/s Anandtex India Pvt. Limited, Panipat, Haryana - Closure thereof.

WHEREAS, the Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one the Grossly Polluting Industries (GPIs) in the country which have been discharging pollutants directly or indirectly into ambient air and water, which pose constant threat to cause adverse effect on air and water quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from industries under the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986 and rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, holistic approach has been adopted to cover entire Ganga River Basin which cover the states of; Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Delhi, and parts of Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand and West Bengal; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986 and rules framed there under and also meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs) / Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and



WHEREAS, M/s Anandtex India Pvt. Limited, Panipat, Haryana is involved in the process of Textile/ Yarn dyeing, printing and bleaching etc.;

WHEREAS, in order to verify the compliance status of the industry, a team from Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) carried out an inspection of M/s Anandtex India Pvt. Limited on May 30, 2018 and found that the industry was closed. Therefore, the inspection of unit in operating condition could not be carried out.

WHEREAS, Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.


NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, M/s Anandtex India Pvt. Limited, Panipat, Haryana is hereby directed to remain closed and shall not resume the operation of unit without permission of CPCB.

M/s Anandtex International Private Limited (AIPL), Risalu Road, Panipat, Haryana shall submit its reply within 15 days from the date of issue of the directions. In case of failure of the directions, the Board will be constraint to initiate action as deemed necessary and appropriate in the circumstances under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, without giving any further notice.
