Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to M/s Anandtex International Private Limited, Panipat, Haryana - Show Cause thereof.

WHEREAS, the Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one the Grossly Polluting Industries (GPIs) in the country which have been discharging pollutants directly or indirectly into ambient air and water, which pose constant threat to cause adverse effect on air and water quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from industries under the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986 and rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, holistic approach has been adopted to cover entire Ganga River Basin which cover the states of; Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Delhi, and parts of Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand and West Bengal; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986 and rules framed there under and also meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs) / Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, M/s Anandtex International Private Limited (AIPL), Risalu Road, Panipat, Haryana is involved in the process of Textile/ Yarn dyeing, printing and bleaching etc.;

WHEREAS, in order to verify the compliance status of the industry, a team from Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) carried out an inspection of M/s AIPL on May 15, 2018 and made the following observations:

1. M/s AIPL has a valid consent to operate (CTO) under Air and Water Acts, 1981 & 1974 as well as Hazardous Waste Authorisation valid up to 30.09.2018.
2. The industry was found operational during the inspection and the ETP was also found operational. The treated effluent was found to be discharged partially outside the plant premises.
3. **The effluent discharge sample was found to be non-complying with the prescribed standard of pH: 9.61 against the standard of 5.5 to 9.0.**


WHEREAS, Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to

the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the non-compliances mentioned above and in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, M/s Anandtex International Private Limited (AIPL), Risalu Road, Panipat, Haryana is directed to show cause as to why the industry should not be closed for the shortcomings as highlighted above and environmental compensation be not imposed in respect of these violations.


M/s Anandtex International Private Limited, Panipat, Haryana is further directed to immediately take necessary corrective measures to ensure compliance of prescribed standards and shall also submit effluent analysis report from an EPA/ NABL recognised lab as evidence in this regard within one month.

M/s Anandtex International Private Limited (AIPL), Risalu Road, Panipat, Haryana shall submit its reply to show cause notice within 15 days from the date of issue of the directions. In case of failure, the Board will be constraint to initiate action as deemed necessary and appropriate in the circumstances under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, without giving any further notice.
