Sub.: Direction issued under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986- Revoke reg.

WHEREAS, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs) for installation of online emission monitoring system and online effluent monitoring system w.r.t. pH, COD, BOD, TSS and Flow parameters in Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries; and

WHEREAS, concerned SPCB / PCC have issued directions under section 33A of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 to install the online monitoring system by June 30, 2015 and to submit bank guarantee of 100% of the cost of online effluent monitoring system; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Arafat Leather Finishers, a tannery unit (here in after referred as the Unit) located at 201/194-B, Ramrai Sarai, Jajmau, Kanpur, UP, was inspected on 21.04.2017, by the team of officials deputed by CPCB and observed the following:

- 1) The industry was in operation on the date of inspection and the ETP was in operation.
- 2) Though the industry has installed the Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS) and has provided the connectivity with CPCB server, the OCEMS details registered at the CPCB registration portal are not complete.
- 3) The Hazardous Waste Authorization (HWA) submitted by the industry has expired on 12/05/2016.

AND WHEREAS, CBCB issued show cause notice dated 27.06.2017, under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; to the Unit, and

WHEREAS, the unit reply vide their letters dated: 14.07.2017 and 15.09.2017 were examined and the following observations are made:

- (i) The unit has registered on CPCB portal and provided the connectivity with server.
- (ii) The unit has submitted the copy of application for Hazardous waste authorization applied to UPPCB.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, the show cause notice dated 27.06.2017 is hereby revoked and M/s Arafat Leather Finishers 201/194-B, Ramrai Sarai, Jajmau Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh is directed to comply with the following:

- (i) The Unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged by the Unit will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB / inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated into the CETP.
- (ii) The Unit shall always ensure data transmission to CPCB server.
- (iii) The unit shall submit the copy of valid Hazardous waste authorization to CPCB within 15 days of receipt from the UPPCB.
- (iv) The Unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognised under the E (P) Act, 1986 within 30 days.

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
