Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 – Notice Thereof

WHEREAS, the Oil Refineries industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self-monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent and emission monitoring devices; and

WHEREAS, Unit has provided the connectivity of the online monitoring system of all 44 Stacks and for Effluent data to the CPCB as per the verification report of IT division, CPCB; and

WHEREAS, Unit has shortlisted for inspection on October 10, 2017 based on the SMS alerts received during August 15, 2017 to September 15, 2017; and

WHEREAS, Central Pollution Control Board, Regional Directorate, Bengaluru inspected the unit from October 30, 2017 to November 03, 2017 and observed the following:

1. Emissions discharged from CCRU – 206 F3 and F6 stacks are exceeding the norms w.r.t SO₂ 53.8 > 50 mg/ NM₃ of and PM 15.4 > 10 mg/ NM₃.
2. It was observed that the roof of the shelter of online gaseous measuring system near SRU unit is damaged and rain water may enter which may lead to damaging the analyser.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, notice is hereby issued to **M/s Chennai Petroleum Corporation Ltd, Manali, Tamilnadu** to show cause as to why your unit not be directed to close down all operational activities with immediate effect until following directions are compiled:

1. The unit shall upgrade/ maintain the Air Pollution Control System CCRU – 206 F3 and F6 stacks so that discharged emissions may be within Standard limit.
2. The unit shall repair roof of the shelter of online gaseous measuring system near SRU unit to prevent contact of rain with OCEMS sensor.

The time bound action plan for compliance of above directions shall be submitted to Central Pollution Control Board within 15 days of the receipt of the directions. In case of failure to comply with the said directions necessary action as deemed fit under the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be taken by Central Pollution Control Board.
