DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rule framed there under; and

WHEREAS, all industries are required to install and regularly operate the requisite pollution control facilities to comply with the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants; and

WHEREAS, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention and control of pollution), 1974 and the Air (Prevention and control of pollution), 1981 was issued on 05-02-2014 to all the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs)/Pollution Control Committees PCCs) for ensuring installation of online emission and effluent monitoring system by grossly polluting industries; and

WHEREAS, considering the requests/ representations received from industrial associations/ SPCBs/PCCs, an extension of time upto June 30, 2015 for installation of online monitoring system was granted vide direction dated March 27, 2015 under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention and control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981; and

WHEREAS, a letter vide dated 29-05-2015 was issued by the Chairman CPCB to all the SPCBs/PCCs informing that no further extension of time will be given after June 30, 2015 and withdrawal of consent to operate along with forfeiture of bank guarantee of non-complying units will be only option; and

WHEREAS, concerned SPCB /PCC have issued directions under section 33 (A) of the Water (Prevention and control of pollution) Act, 1974 and section 31 (A) of the Air (Prevention and control of pollution) Act, 1981 to install the online monitoring system by June 30, 2015 and to submit bank guarantee of 100% of the cost of online emission and effluent monitoring system; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by the officials of Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) on 23-03-2017; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 27/29.04.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

WHEREAS, the Unit **M/s Hari Om Gramodhyog, Plot No. 439, Village- Sandila, P.O. Mandhna (Mandhna Bithoor Road), Kanpur-209217, Uttar Pradesh** was inspected by the officials of Regional Directorate (North), Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) on 19-07-2017 and following observations are made :

1. On the day of visit, the unit was found in operation, which is in violation of CPCB closure direction.
2. The unit is engaged in production of Kattha and Cutch with capacity of 160 kg per day and 80 kg per day respectively. During inspection the unit was in operation with present production of 120 kg per day of Kattha and 40 kg per day of Cutch.

3. The name of the unit and environmental data was not displayed on the main gate of the unit.
4. Logbook for operation of ETP, consumption of chemical, energy meter etc. was not maintained by the unit.
5. The unit has two borewells for industrial and domestic purpose. No flow measuring device was installed at the tube well.
6. The unit has ETP, which comprises of collection tank, Reaction Tank, Tube settler, Feed tank, Pressure sand filter, activated carbon filter, treated effluent collection tank.
7. The ETP was not in operation at the time of inspection.
8. It was observed that the effluent was discharged on land within the premises.
9. The chemical dosing tank, tube settler were found empty which reveals that unit was not operating its ETP for many days.
10. A by-pass line from collection tank was observed at the time of inspection.
11. The unit has not installed OCEMS at the outlet of ETP.
12. The unit has not installed any flow measuring device at the outlet of ETP to assess quantity of effluent generation.
13. The unit has not installed separate energy meter for the operation of ETP.
14. The unit has one boilers using diesel and wood chips as fuel. Emission from boiler is emitted through stack of height 90 ft. followed by Cyclone Separator as APCD.
15. The unit has two DG sets equipped without acoustic enclosure and inadequate stack height.
16. The house keeping was unsatisfactory.
17. The unit does not have permission from CGWA for the abstraction of ground water.

WHEREAS, the unit's replies vide letters dated 18-08-2017, 22-08-2017 and 30-08-2017 were examined and following observation are made:

- a) The unit has not received CPCB closure direction dated 27/2904-2017 till 31.08.2017.
- b) The unit was informed by SPCB about the closure and unit has downloaded the copy of the direction from CPCB website.
- c) The unit has produced Kattha from Khairwood only without any kind of chemical.
- d) The unit is fully complying with the consent conditions.
- e) ETP is in functional with logbook. There is no by pass as mentioned in the direction. No effluent is discharged into any drain or nearby areas or river.
- f) The unit does not fall in GPI category and is therefore exempted from installation of online monitoring system.
- g) The present discharge from the unit is below one KL per day and no chemical has been used ever.
- h) Log book is maintained at all time.
- i) Flow meter has been purchased in the month of July.
- j) There is only one DG set operating with Canopy and adequate stock height.
- k) There is a proper display of unit name and environmental data which has been shifted to a new gate (Old gate is to be completely dismantled).
- l) Housekeeping is excellent with proper greenery.
- m) The unit has submitted an undertaking duly notarized by Notary.

AND WHEREAS, the unit was inspected on 19.07.2017 and found that the unit has not closed its manufacturing operations which is in violation of CPCB direction dated 27/29-04-2017 issued under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and for which appropriate legal action shall be taken separately; and

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF &CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the three member committee in its meeting held on 15.11.2017 examined the inspection report of the Unit and recommended that the Unit may be allowed to resume operation subject to inspection by CPCB/SPCB within one month; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O.157 (E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act,1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules,1986 and amendment thereof; and

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit is directed to comply with the following direction:

1. The unit namely **M/s Hari Om Gramodhyog, Plot No. 439, Village- Sandila, P.O. Mandhna (Mandhna Bithoor Road), Kanpur-209217, Uttar Pradesh** shall resume operation and shall treat their effluent to meet the effluent discharge standards as stipulated by UPPCB.
2. The unit shall inform to CPCB about the resumption of operation.
3. The unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report by the laboratory recognized under the EPA, 1986 within 30 days of resumption of operation.

Failure to comply with above directions will attract action in accordance with the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rule framed there under; and

WHEREAS, the state pollution control board (SPCBs)/Pollution Control Committees (PCCS) can stipulate stringent standards for discharge of environment pollutants from various categories of industries that those notified by the central government, under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and rules framed thereunder; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and rules framed thereunder; and

WHEREAS, M/s Dugdh Utpadak Shakari Sangh Ltd., Mirjapur, Uttar Pradesh (here after referred as the unit) is a dairy industry; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 29.05.2016 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to close all plant operations till compliance with the following directions:

1. The unit shall operate its Effluent Treatment Plant regularly.
2. The unit shall install Online Monitoring System and provide its online connectivity to Central Pollution Control Board.
3. The unit shall install flow meter at the bore well.
4. The unit shall maintain logbook for the water consumption, waste water generation, and fuel consumption.

AND WHEREAS, the unit's replies vide letters dated 22.08.2017 and 23.09.2017 were examined and following observations are made:

1. The unit regularly operates effluent treatment plant.
2. The unit has installed Online Monitoring System and provide its online connectivity to CPCB.
3. The unit has installed flow meter at the borewell.
4. The unit has been prepared log book for the water consumption, waste water generation and fuel consumption and maintained properly.

AND WHEREAS, the unit has completed registration and provide OCEMS connectivity to the CPCB server: and

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF &CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the three member committee in its meeting held on 31.10.2017 examined replies of the Unit and recommended that the Unit may be allowed to resume operation; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of emission and effluent standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, closure direction dated 29.05.2017 issued to the unit **M/s Dugdh Utpadak Shakari Sangh Ltd., Mirjapur, Uttar Pradesh** is hereby revoked and the unit is directed to comply with the following direction:

- (i) The unit shall resume operation and shall treat their effluent to meet the effluent discharge standards as notified under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 after seeking valid consent to operate under Water/Air Acts from Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board.
- (ii) The unit shall ensure continuous connectivity with CPCB server.
- (iii) The unit shall submit water effluent analysis report from laboratory recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days of resumption of operations.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate action without any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rule framed there under; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharged standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs)/Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, the industry is required to obtain, from the State Pollution Control Board, the Consent to Operate under Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981; and

WHEREAS, it is required to obtain permission from Central Ground Water Authority to abstract Ground Water for industrial use; and

WHEREAS, M/s Hindustan Coca-Cola Beverage Pvt. Ltd., Mahandiganj, Raja Talab, District-Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh-250402 (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is manufacturing soft drinks; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected on 21-03-2017 and the following observations made:

1. The unit does not have valid consent to operate under Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981.
2. The unit does not have valid permission from CGWA to abstract groundwater for industrial use.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of emission and effluent standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued show cause notice dated 28.06.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit for operating without valid consent and incomplete registration; and

WHEREAS, the unit reply vide letters dated 20.07.2017, 21.07.2017 and 25.07.2017 were examined and found that the unit has obtained valid consent upto 28.08.2017 from Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board (UPPCB) and also obtained CGWA permission for groundwater abstraction valid upto 16-07-2019; and

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Show cause notice dated 28.6.2017 is hereby revoked and the unit namely **M/s Hindustan Coca-Cola Beverage Pvt. Ltd., Mahandiganj, Raja Talab, District-Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh-250402** is directed to comply with the following direction:

1. The Unit shall treat their effluent to meet the effluent discharge standards as notified under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.
2. The Unit shall ensure continuous connectivity with CPCB server.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate action without any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rule framed there under; and

WHEREAS, Dairy units are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, for strengthening the monitoring and compliance through self regulatory mechanism, online source emission and effluent monitoring systems need to be installed and operated by the industries on 'polluter pays principle'; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of emission and effluent standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharged standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs)/Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, M/s Shreedhar Milk Foods Pvt. Limited, Ikonda Road, Joya, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is manufacturing ghee and milk powder; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected by CPCB officials on 16.04.2017 and found that the unit has non-compliance with respect to high value of BOD-128 mg/l (against norms of 30 mg/l), COD-441 (against norms of 250 mg/l) and TSS-410 mg/l (against norms of 100 mg/l); and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued directions dated 27.06.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to close down operation with immediate effect and not to restart operation till compliance with the following directions:

1. The unit shall close down manufacturing of processes Milk and its products with immediate effect.
2. The unit shall report to CPCB regarding closure of manufacturing operations in compliance of the direction immediately on receipt of this direction.
3. The operation and performance of ETP shall be upgraded so as to meet the notified effluent discharge standards.

4. The unit shall obtain permission from Central Ground Water Board for extraction of groundwater.
5. After completion of the above said measures, the unit shall report to CPCB and seek permission from CPCB before resumption of any manufacturing operations.

WHEREAS, the unit reply vide letter dated 08.07.2017, 01.08.2017 and 05.05.2017 were examined and following observations made:

1. The unit has closed the all manufacturing operations w.e.f 06.07.2017.
2. The unit has full fledged ETP installed in the unit with a capacity to handle 4, 40,000 of waste water per day for treatment consisting of the following section/equipments.
 - i. 01 Oil & grease Separator chamber (50 KL)
 - ii. 01 Equalization Tank (70 KL)
 - iii. 02 Arid Grid Distribution System (200m³/hr)
 - iv. 01 Flocculator (I& II)-2000x800x1000 MM
 - v. 01 Tube settler- (I&II)-350x1500x3500 MM
 - vi. 01 B1-Media Filter- 20m³/hr
 - vii. 01 Activated Carbon Filter - 20m³/hr
 - viii. 01 Sludge Drying Bed-02 KL
3. The ETP is being operator efficiently and continuously as per the process requirement.
4. As regards high value of the BOD, COD & TSS reported in the sample kindly note the unit having online monitored unit by UPPCB & CPCB daily treated water parameters are available online. The relevant data for the period under reference are within the accepted norms as may be observed at UPPCB & CPCB server with which unit monitory system.
5. The unit has applied to the CGWA for permission of ground water extraction.
6. An ETP treated water sample was drawn on 01.07.2017 by NABL approved lab M/s Neweon Consultants. The test results for this sample are well within the norms.
7. The treated effluent is used for gardening and horticulture purpose. Only as permitted by UPPCB and not a single drop of treated effluent drain into Ganga River.
8. The unit has established fully equipped lab for analysis of various environmental parameters.
9. Regarding low MLSS/MVLSS at 180 mg/l & 142 mg/l, kindly note the unit has ETP system/technology is different & based on OZO-Tech and not on Bacteria/Biological technology of SBR. Therefore, the level of MLSS/MLVSS has no relevance for treated water parameters in the unit as MLSS is not developed in aeration tank.
10. Kindly note this technology is approved/accepted by UPPCB.
11. The unit has submitted affidavit duly notarized as per prescribed format.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit **M/s Shreedhar Milk Foods Pvt. Limited, Ikonda Road, Joya, Uttar Pradesh** is hereby revoked and directed to comply with the following direction:


- (i) The unit shall resume operation and shall treat their effluent to meet the effluent discharge standards as notified under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.

DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, Food, Dairy and Beverage units are identified as one of the grossly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rule framed there under; and

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self-monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent and emission monitoring devices; and

WHEREAS, for strengthening the monitoring and compliance through self regulatory mechanism, online source emission and effluent monitoring systems need to be installed and operated by the industries on 'polluter pays principle'; and

WHEREAS, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs)/Pollution Control Committees (PCCs) for installation of online effluent monitoring system w.r.t. pH, BOD, COD, TSS and flow parameters; and

WHEREAS, considering the request/representations received from industries/industrial associations/SSPCBs/PCCs, an extension of time up to June 30, 2015 for installation of online monitoring system was granted vide direction dated March 02, 2015 under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981; and

WHEREAS, a letter vide dated May 29, 2015 was issued by the Chairman, CPCB to all the SPCBs/PCCs informing that no further extension of time will be given after June 30, 2015 and withdrawal of consent to operate along with forfeiture of bank guarantee of non-compliance units; and

WHEREAS, concerned SPCBs/PCCs issued directions under section 33 A of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 to install the online monitoring system by June 30, 2015 and to submit bank guarantee of 100% of the cost of online emission & effluent monitoring system; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of emission and effluent standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, a team of officials from CPCB inspected the unit on 23.03.2017 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures and the following observations are made:

1. The unit is engaged in processing of raw milk (capacity: 15000 litres/day).
2. The OCEMS was not installed at the final outlet of ETP.
3. The fresh water requirement of the unit was meeting through a bore well and water meter was not installed at the extraction point of the borewell.
4. The logbook for freshwater consumption, wastewater generation, fuel consumption, etc was not maintained by the unit.
5. The treated effluent discharge from ETP outlet is meeting the prescribed standards.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB issued directions dated 25.04.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to close down operation with immediate effect and not to restart operation till compliance with the following directions:

1. The unit shall install and provide data connectivity of OCEMS in compliance of CPCB guidelines.
2. The unit install flow meter devices at freshwater extraction point, inlet/outlet of the ETP etc.
3. The unit shall maintain the logbook for fresh water consumption, wastewater generation, treated waste water disposal, fuel/energy consumption etc.
4. The unit shall maintain good housekeeping as per GMP & GHP procedure.

AND WHEREAS, the unit reply vide letter dated 14.07.2017, 13.08.2017, 17.08.2017 and 21.08.2017 were examined and following observations made:

- (i) The unit has been installed OCEMS.
- (ii) The unit has installed flow meter at inlet and outlet of the ETP.
- (iii) The unit has maintained all logbooks.
- (iv) The unit has submitted self-certificate vide letter dt. 17.08.2017 wherein the unit has mentioned that the unit has stopped the operations w.e.f. 03.08.2017 in compliance of the closure direction dt. 25-04-2017.
- (v) The unit has submitted latest consent application

AND WHEREAS, IT division, CPCB has confirmed that the unit has provided OCEMS data connectivity to CPCB server; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected by CPCB with district administration team and the unit was found in operation which is in violation of CPCB closure direction dt. 25.04.2017 and also in contradiction of self certificate dt 17.08.2017 by the unit informing that the unit has stopped operations w.e.f. 3.08.2017, for which legal action shall be initiate against the unit separately; and

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit **M/s Dugdh Utpadak Sahkari Sangh Ltd., Near Tiwari Talab, Allahabad, Uttar Pradesh** closure direction is hereby revoked and directed to comply with the following direction:

- (i) The unit shall resume operation and shall treat their effluent to meet the effluent discharge standards as notified under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.
- (ii) The unit shall ensure continuous connectivity with CPCB server.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate action without any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rule framed there under; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of emission and effluent standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharged standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs)/Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, M/s Gujrat Ambuja Exports Ltd., C-50, Eldeco SIDCUL Industrial Park, Sitarganj, Dist. Udham Singh Nagar-262403, Uttarakhand (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is engaged in food processing for manufacturing of starch and its derivatives; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued directions dated 13.06.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to close down all its manufacturing operations and not to restart manufacturing till complies with following directions:

1. The Unit shall obtain consents under Water and Air Acts which expired on 31.03.2017.
2. The Unit shall obtain NOC from CGWA.
3. The Unit shall make ETP to meet the prescribed standards of effluent discharge.

AND WHEREAS, the unit reply vide letter dated 27.06.2017 was examined and following observations made:

- (i) The Unit has submitted copies of consent under Air and Water Acts with validity upto 31.03.2018.
- (ii) The Unit has applied for NOC to CGWA.
- (iii) The Unit is a CETP connected unit and effluent after primary treatment is being sent to CETP.
- (iv) The test results of samples collected by CPCB representatives are also well within norms of CEPT discharge norms with BOD-330 mg/l (as against norm of 550 mg/l), COD-756 mg/l (as against norm of 900 mg/l, Oil & Grease- <4.0 mg/l (as against norm of 20 mg/l) and pH-8.26 (as against norm of 5.5-9.0).
- (v) The Unit undertakes that it would continue to comply with prescribed discharge standards in accordance to limits prescribed in the norms.
- (vi) The Unit has requested to revoke the closure direction.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Unit **M/s Gujrat Ambuja Exports Ltd., C-50, Eldico SIDCUL Industrial Park, Sitarganj, District-Udham Singh Nagar-262403, Uttarakhand** is hereby directed to comply with the following direction:

- (i) The Unit shall resume operation and shall treat their effluent to meet the prescribed effluent discharge standards.
- (ii) The Unit shall ensure continuous connectivity with CPCB server of the OCEMS.
- (iii) The Unit shall obtain NOC from CGWA.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate action without any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

WHEREAS, CPCB issued directions dated 26-04-2017, under Section 5 Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the **M/s Premier Agri Foods Pvt. Ltd. (Formerly Known as Premier Milk Foods Pvt. Ltd.)**, NH-24, Village- Andharpura, Faridpur, Bareilly, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') to close down all the manufacturing operation immediately till installation and connectivity for submission of on-line 24 x 7 monitoring data to SPCB/PCCs and CPCB and complied with other related directions.

WHEREAS, the Unit has replied vide its letter dated 20-05-2017 and informed it has complied with the directions regarding installation and commissioning of on-line effluent monitoring system (OCEMS). The unit has provided URL & password to access the data submitted from OCEMS and requested to revoke the closure directions; and

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit is directed to comply with the following direction:

1. The Unit may resume manufacturing operations initially for 30 days on trial.
2. The Unit shall immediately inform to CPCB regarding the resumption of operations.
3. The Unit shall operate ETP properly so as to ensure compliance with the effluent discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. At any stage, if the treated effluent does not meet notified discharge standards the unit shall close down manufacturing operations immediately and report to CPCB.

In case of failure of the unit **M/s Premier Agri Foods Pvt. Ltd. (Formerly Known as Premier Milk Foods Pvt. Ltd.)**, NH-24, Village- Andharpura, Faridpur, Bareilly, Uttar Pradesh to comply with the norms action as deemed appropriate will be taken with provisions under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
