Revoking of closure direction under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries have been identified as one the Grossly Polluting Industries (GPI) which have been discharging effluents directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on land and the ambient water quality; and

WHEREAS, for strengthening the monitoring and compliance through self-regulatory mechanism, online source emission and effluent monitoring systems need to be installed and operated by the industries on 'polluter pays principle'; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & control of pollution) Act, 1974 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all 11 Ganga Basin State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs)/Pollution Control Committee (PCC) for installation of online effluent monitoring system w.r.t. pH, BOD, TSS, COD and flow parameters in Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries; and

WHEREAS, it was clarified that flow meter & web camera may be installed in case of units with Zero Liquid Discharge (ZLD) by March 31, 2015 vide guidelines uploaded on website of CPCB dated November 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, considering the requests/representations received from industries/industrial associations /SPCBs/PCCS, an extension of time up to June 30, 2015 for installation of online monitoring systems was granted vide direction dated March 27, 2015 under section 18 (1) (b) of Water (Prevention & control of pollution) Act, 1974; and

WHEREAS, a letter vide dated May 29, 2015 was issued to the Chairman CPCB to all the SPCBs/PCCS informing that no further extension of time will be given after June 30, 2015 and withdrawal of consents to operate along with forfeiture of bank guarantee of non-complying Units will be the only option; and

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WHEREAS, a direction under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1987 regarding installation of online effluent monitoring system has been issued to unit on dated 21-06-2016 and hereby directed to comply with the following directions:

1. The Unit shall submit documentary evidence regarding status of installation of online effluent monitoring system.
2. The unit shall submit the details as per Annexure-I through
 - (a) E-mail ID- cems.cpcb@nic.in & ngrba.cpcb@nic.in
 - (b) Uploading the data on the link provided on CPCB website (www.cpcb.nic.in) and
 - (c) By speed post to the Member Secretary, Central Pollution Control Board.

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by a team, authorised by CPCB on 12. 04.2017 to verify the compliance status and following observations were made:

1. OCEMS neither installed nor connected, still placed order only.
2. Team observed multiple discharge possibility of direct discharge in drain.

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction on 27.06.2017 to the unit and directed to comply with the following directions;

1. Close all operations of the unit with immediate effect till online effluent monitoring system is installed & the same are uplinked with CPCB website;
2. Stop multiple discharges; and
3. Upgrade ETP to meet standards.

AND WHEREAS, the unit's reply dated 09.06.2017 and 23.08.2017 were examined and following observations are made:

1. The unit has installed the Online Monitoring System.
2. Consent for air as well as water is valid upto 31.12.2019.
3. The unit has applied vide letter dated 21.05.2017 for NOC to CGWB for Ground Water abstraction.
4. Treated effluent analysis report submitted by the unit shows as complying with the parameters (pH, colour, TSS, COD, BOD, Total Chromium and Oil & Grease).
5. The unit has submitted self-certificate and undertaking.

WHEREAS, Status of connectivity of OCEMS of the unit was verified by IT Division, CPCB; and

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF &CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three-member committee in its meeting held on 31.10.2017 examined the replies of the Unit and recommended that the Unit may be allowed to resume operation;

AND NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit (M/s Radhey Processors C - 40, UPSIDC, Rooma, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh) is allowed to resume its manufacturing operations subject to the following condition;


1. The unit shall comply with the prescribed effluent quality norms.
2. The unit shall ensure that the installed online monitoring devices are functioning properly and continuously and that data from the devices are uninterruptedly transferred to CPCB. Any failure in this regard shall be intimated to CPCB with reasons thereof and shall be rectified at the earliest.
3. The unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from lab recognised under Environmental (P) Act, 1986 within 30 days of resumption of operation.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions or any other exigencies, CPCB will be constrained to initiate further stringent action against **the Unit (M/s Radhey Processors C - 40, UPSIDC, Rooma, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh)**, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, without any further notice.
