Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 –reg.

WHEREAS, the **Textile** industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, the CPCB issued closure direction dated 18.05.2017 under Section 5 of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986 to the M/s Prakash Dyeing Centre Near Ram Sajiwan Lal Inter College, Khamaria, Bhadohi-221306, Uttar Pradesh, (herein after referred as the Unit) for compliance of following directions;

1. The unit shall take required steps to make the existing ETP functional or to provide new ETP, so as to meet the stipulated standards for discharge of effluent.
2. The unit shall install the required OCEMS at the ETP outlet and provide connectivity to SPCB/CPCB.
3. The unit shall provide required flow meters at the bore well, ETP inlet and outlet and maintained records of fresh water consumption and waste water generation. CGWA permission, as per applicable rules shall be obtained for withdrawal of groundwater.

AND WHEREAS, the Unit reply vide letters dated 25.09.2017 and 25.10.2017 were examined and following observations are made;

1. The unit has stopped all the operation with effect from 18.05.2017 in compliance of closure direction issued by CPCB.
2. The unit has submitted the Self-Certificate and Self- Declaration as per CPCB format.
3. The unit has valid consents under Air and Water Acts with validity upto 31.12.2017 and submitted application for NOC to CGWA for water extraction.
4. The unit has connected the OCEMS with CPCB server and which is confirmed by IT division, CPCB.

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5. The unit has installed flow metre at raw water feed pump and inlet and outlet of ETP. New ETP with adequate capacity and latest technology has been designed and constructed with screen chamber, oil & grease chamber, collection tank, flash mixer, flocculation tank, settling tank, MBBR tank, Aeration tank, secondary settling tank, sand filter and carbon filter.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three-member committee in its meeting held on 15.11.2017 examined the replies dated 25.09.2017 and 25.10.2017 and recommended for revoke of closure direction dated 18.05.2017.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, the closure direction dated 18.05.2017 is revoked and the unit M/s Prakash Dyeing Centre Near Ram Sajiwan Lal Inter College, Khamaria, Bhadohi-221306, Uttar Pradesh is hereby directed to comply with the following directions;

1. The unit shall resume the manufacturing operation and inform immediately to CPCB; and
2. The Unit shall ensure all time compliance of the standards of treated effluent as per Gazette notification dated 10.10.2016 under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986; and
3. The Unit shall submit the treated effluent analysis report by the laboratory recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days from the date of resumption of operation.

In case of failure of the unit to comply with the directions, action will be taken in accordance with the provisions under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
