**DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986**

**WHEREAS**, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and other standards and norms; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s B. R.. Papers Pvt. Ltd., Village-Lalpur, Post- Kunda, Jaspur, Udham Singh Nagar, Uttarakhand (hereinafter referred as 'the Unit') is a waste paper based Pulp & Paper Mill, engaged in production of Kraft paper using waste paper as raw material with an installed capacity of 50 TPD; and

**WHEREAS**, Uttarakhand Environment Protection and Pollution Control Board (UEPPCB) issued direction under section 33 (A) of Water Act, 1974 to the unit on 13.03.2015 for implementation of the 'Charter for water recycling & pollution prevention in pulp & paper industries'(herein after referred to as 'The charter'); and

**WHEREAS**, unit was issued a closure direction dated 20.02.2017 under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

**WHEREAS**, unit was issued a revoke direction dated 27.06.2017 under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit for compliance the following direction

1. Unit may resume manufacturing operations initially for 30days only and shall inform to CPCB, immediately the date of resumption of operation.
2. The unit shall operate ETP properly so as to ensure compliance with the effluent discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) rules, 1986. At any stage if the treated effluent does not meet notified discharge norms the unit shall close down manufacturing operations immediately and report to CPCB.

**WHEREAS**, a team of officials of CPCB visited the unit on August 22, 2017 to verify the ETP performance of the unit and made following observations:

- The unit is a small Pulp & Paper unit with consented capacity of 60 TPD, produces Kraft paper using waste paper as raw material.
- The unit & ETP were found operational on the day of inspection.
- The unit has 01 bore well for fresh water requirement and is equipped with water meter.
- The fresh water consumption is about 7.23 KL/MT.
- The ETP of the unit is upgraded up to tertiary treatment (DMF) facility. Waste water from primary clarifier is being used in pulping.
- OCEMS is installed in the unit and is connected with CPCB server.
- The treated effluent of the unit is discharged in local drain (Pachhana) to Dhela river to Ramganga and finally reaches to Ganga river.
- The unit has applied for consent under Air Act & Water Act to UEPPCB.
- Analysis report of ETP treated effluent shows: pH 7.91 ; BOD- 07 mg/l (as against the norms of 30 mg/l); TSS-73 mg/l (as against the norms of 100 mg/l) & COD- 76 mg/l (as against the norms of 250 mg/l);

AND WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF &CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three member committee in its meeting held on 15.11.2017 examined and recommended that the Unit may be allowed to resume operation and shall provide the treated effluent analysis report by EPA recognized lab within 30 days from the date of resumption of operation.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit **M/s B. R. Papers Pvt. Ltd., Village-Lalpur, Post- Kunda, Jaspur, Udham Singh Nagar, Uttarakhand**, is directed to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit may **resume manufacturing operations** and shall inform to CPCB immediately.
2. The unit shall provide ETP treated effluent sample analysis report from the lab recognised under EPA,1986 within 30 days from the date of resumption of operation.
3. The unit shall ensure to provide data connectivity on CPCB server continuously.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
