Directions Under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986- revoke reg.

WHEREAS, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, M/s Leather World, located at 184 A (1), Wajidpur, Jajmau, Kanpur Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred as Unit) is a tannery engaged in processing of raw leather and wet blue leather to produce finished leather; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, the representative (s) of Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) carried out inspection of the unit on 05.04.2017 for verification of compliance to the norms stipulated under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and following observations were made:

- (i) The unit has valid consent under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution), 1974 and Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution), 1981. The validity of authorization under Hazardous Waste (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 was expired at the time of inspection.
- (ii) The treated effluent was found non-compliant w.r.t. TSS (816 mg/l) against the norms of 600 mg/l and Chromium (6.901 mg/l) against the norms of 2 mg/l.
- (iii) The unit has installed chromium recovery plant but the inspection team noticed that it was non-operational.
- (iv) Overall housekeeping of the plant was unsatisfactory.

WHEREAS, CPCB issued Closure direction dated May 22, 2017 to Unit, to close down operations till compliance to the notified effluent discharge standards under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and installation & commissioning online continuous emission monitoring system (OCEMS) along with providing connectivity for submission of online 24 x 7 monitored data to UPPCB and CPCB server; and

WHEREAS, the Unit's replies dt. 07.06.2017, 11.07.2017, 01.08.2017, 15.09.2017 & 20.11.2017 were examined and following observations are made:

- (i) The unit has received authorization (valid upto 29.05.2022) under Hazardous and Other Wastes Rules, 2016.
- (ii) The unit has installed flow meter and providing connectivity for data to UPPCB and CPCB server since 11-08-2016.
- (iii) The unit has submitted undertaking in the required format duly notarized.
- (iv) The unit has submitted self certificate wherein the unit has informed stoppage of all the operations with effect from 01.06.2017.

WHEREAS, CPCB Constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, The Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 22/11/17 examined the replies dated 07.06.2017, 11.07.2017, 01.08.2017, 15.09.2017 & 20.11.2017 and recommended for the revoke of the closure directions with the following conditions:-

- (i) The unit shall maintain log book for Chromium bearing sludge disposal to TSDF. UPPCB shall monitor disposal of Chromium sludge to authorised TSDF site.
- (ii) The analysis result of the treated effluent shall be submitted within 30 days from the date of resumption of operation through EPA recognised laboratory.

AND NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure direction dated 22.05.2017 issued to **M/s Leather World, 184 A (1), Wajidpur, Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh** is hereby revoked and the unit is directed to comply with the following direction:


1. The Unit shall immediately inform to CPCB on resumption of manufacturing process.
2. The Unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged by the Unit will comply the PETP standards / inlet to CETP standards as per the UP Pollution Control Board.
3. The unit shall maintain log book for Chromium bearing sludge disposal to TSDF.
4. The analysis result of the treated effluent shall be submitted within 30 days from the date of resumption of operation through EPA recognised laboratory.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate action without any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
