Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, the tannery and leather industries are also identified as one of the Grossly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly in to ambient Air and Water, having potential to cause adverse effects on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s Rajiv Leather Embossing 47/46 Gajjupurwa Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is a Tannery industry and was inspected by a team of officials authorized by CPCB on 28.03.2017 to verify the compliance status; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued direction dated 12.06.2017 under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit to close all plant operations and not to restart until it complies with the following directions:

1. The Unit shall install adequate Effluent Treatment Plant and operate it properly so as to achieve prescribed standards for effluent discharge.
2. The Unit shall register in CPCB registration portal for online monitoring system.

AND WHEREAS, a team of officials from CPCB carried out inspection of M/s. Rajiv Leather Embossing, 47/46, Gajjupurwa, Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh on 01/08/2017 to verify the compliance status of closure direction dated 12.06.2017 and following observations were made:

1. On the day of inspection the unit was not in operation but as informed by the unit that they had restarted the regular production since 29/07/2017
2. The Unit has Water consent issued under Water Act valid till 31/12/2018.

AND WHEREAS, the unit's letter dated 06/07/2017 and 23/08/2017 were examined and following observations are made:

- i) The unit has constructed a chamber within the effluent drain and screens has been places at various locations within the drain.
- ii) The Unit has submitted copy of consents issued under Water Act valid till 31/12/2018 and copy of Authorization issued for Hazardous Waste valid till 21/04/2021.
- iii) The unit has submitted the Self certificate and undertaking.
- iv) The Unit has completed the registration of OCEMS on CPCB portal.
- v) The unit has submitted treated effluent analysis report to CPCB.

WHEREAS, CPCB Constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC & NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, The Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 21/11/17 examined the unit's replies dated 06/07/2017 and 23/08/2017 and recommended for the revoke of the closure direction.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure dated June 12th, 2017 issued to **M/s Rajiv Leather Embossing 47/46 Gajjupurwa Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh** is hereby revoked and the unit is directed to comply the following:

1. The unit shall construct an additional sludge drying bed.
2. The Unit shall submit treated effluent quality analysis report from recognised laboratory under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days after resume of operation.
3. Unit shall maintain logbook of Hazardous waste disposal to TSDF.
4. The Unit shall immediately inform to CPCB on resumption of manufacturing operation.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions or any other exigencies, CPCB will be constrained to initiate further action against the unit, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, without any further notice.
