Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, the tannery and leather industries are also identified as one of the Grossly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly in to ambient Air and Water, having potential to cause adverse effects on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s Everest Tannery (P) Ltd. Unit-III, B-11, LTP Banther, Unnao, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is a Tannery industry and was inspected by a team of officials authorized by CPCB on 12.04.2017 to verify the compliance status; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated June 12th, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit for not complying with the prescribed discharge standard; and

WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letter dated 17/07/2017, 12/08/2017, 26/08/2017, 06/09/2017 and 13/09/2017 were examined and following observations are made:

- i) The unit has installed screen in effluent carrying drains and chambers
- ii) Increased the dosing of sulphuric acid and alum into the chemical dosing system.
- iii) The capacity of lifting pump from collection tank to settling tank has also been decreased.
- iv) The unit has submitted the self-certificate and undertaking and treated effluent analysis report to CPCB.
- v) Provided copy of expired consent issued under Air and Water Act valid till 30/06/2017 and copy of renewal application of consents and copy of authorization issued for Hazardous waste valid till 24/10/2018.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB Constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC & NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, The Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 21/11/17 examined the unit's replies dated 17/07/2017, 12/08/2017, 26/08/2017, 06/09/2017 and 13/09/2017 and recommended for the revoke of the closure direction.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure direction dated June 12th, 2017 issued to **M/s Everest Tannery (P) Ltd. Unit-III, B-11, LTP Banther, Unnao, Uttar Pradesh** is hereby revoked and the unit is directed to comply the following directions:

1. The Unit, shall resume its manufacturing operation after obtaining valid consent under Water Act 1974 and Air Act 1981 from UPPCB.
2. The Unit shall install filtration arrangement for treated effluent to meet the prescribed norms.
3. The Unit shall submit treated effluent quality analysis report from recognised laboratory under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days after resume of operation.
4. Unit shall maintain logbook of Hazardous waste disposal to TSDF.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions or any other exigencies, CPCB will be constrained to initiate further action against the unit, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, without any further notice.
