Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 –reg.

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, the CPCB issued closure direction dated 12.06.2017 to the M/s Amber Textiles, D-16 A-III, Site No. 2, Panki Industrial Area, Kanpur-208022, Uttar Pradesh (herein after referred as the Unit) for incomplete compliance of following directions;

1. The unit shall immediately close down all the plant operations.
2. The unit shall obtain valid Hazardous Waste Authorization from UPPCB.
3. To provide adequate treatment to ETP to meet the prescribed standard in terms of TSS, BOD, O & G, COD, Sulphide and Phenol.
4. The unit shall install the OCEMS and connected with CPCB server.
5. To obtain permission from CGWA to draw groundwater.
6. After completion of the above said measures, the unit shall report to CPCB and seek permission from CPCB before resumption of their plant operations;

AND WHEREAS, the Unit reply vide letters dated 18.07.2017, 22.07.2017, 12.08.2017, 16.09.2017 and 22.09.2017 were examined and following observations are made;

1. The unit has stopped all the operations with effect from 15.07.2017 in compliance of the closure direction issued by CPCB.
2. The unit has consent under Air and Water Acts valid upto 31.12.2017 and submitted Membership Certificate for Hazardous Waste Authorization with Bharat Oil and Waste Management Ltd.

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3. The unit has installed water flow meter at raw water intake point and are maintaining log book for the same. Installed new oil & trap system and modified equalization tank due to consideration of deviation in parameters pertaining to Phenol and Sulphide content in the discharged effluent. Installed new stirrer for mixing of coagulants in PST and SST, new tube settler and new activated carbon filter for reduction of BOD, COD & TSS from discharged effluent.
4. The unit has submitted details of connectivity of the OCEMS with the CPCB server.
5. The unit have applied for NOC to CGWA for groundwater abstraction.
6. The unit has submitted the Self Certificate and Self Declaration (Affidavit) as per CPCB format.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three-member committee in its meeting held on 21.11.2017 examined the replies dated 18.07.2017, 22.07.2017, 12.08.2017, 16.09.2017 and 22.09.2017 and recommended for revoke of closure direction dated 12.06.2017.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, the closure direction dated 12.06.2017 is revoked and the unit M/s Amber Textiles, D 16 A III, Site No. 2, Panki Industrial Area, Kanpur-208022, Uttar Pradesh is hereby directed to comply with the following directions;

1. The unit shall resume the manufacturing operation and inform immediately to CPCB.
2. The Unit shall ensure all time compliance of the standards of treated effluent as per Gazette notification dated 10.10.2016 under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.
3. The Unit shall submit the treated effluent analysis report by the laboratory recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days from the date of resumption of operation.

In case of failure of the unit to comply with the directions, action will be taken in accordance with the provisions under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
