Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986-reg.

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s U.P.Dyeing & Printing works, (hereafter referred as the Unit), is a textile industry located at 68, Nauchandi Ground, Meerut, UP; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected by CPCB officials on 10-04-2017 and following observation were made:

1. The unit was operational on the day of visit and the consent was awaited for the current year 2017-18.
2. The unit has not installed Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS).
3. The unit source the water from the bore well and consumes around 16 m³/day of fresh water and waste water discharge around 14 m³/day.
4. The unit does not have any permission from CGWA for extraction of fresh water from bore well.

WHEREAS, CBCB issued closure direction dated 15.05.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; to the Unit to close down till installation of online continuous effluent monitoring system (OCEMS) and connectivity with CPCB/SPCB; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 28.06.2017 under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to the unit; and

WHEREAS, the unit reply vide letters dated 01.08.2017, 18.08.2017, 11.09.2017 and 01.11.2017 are examined and the following observation are made-

- i) the unit has installed OCEMS and provided connectivity with CPCB server.
- ii) the unit has submitted self certificate mentioning that it has stopped the operations with effect from 08.07.2017.
- iii) the unit has submitted notarized Affidavit dated 01.11.2017.
- iv) the unit has applied consent (valid up to 31.12.2017) for trade effluent discharge of 13KL/day, under the Water Act 1974, to Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board.
- v) the unit has ETP system consisting of equalization tank, flash mixer, tube settler and sludge drying bed.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB Constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 16/11/17 examined the unit's replies dated 01.08.2017, 18.08.2017, 11.09.2017 and 01.11.2017 and recommended for the revoke of the closure directions dated 15-05-2017 and 28-06-2017; and submit copy to CPCB.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, the closure directions dated 15-05-2017 and 28.06.2017 are revoked and the unit M/s U.P.Dyeing & Printing works, 68, Nauchandi Ground, Meerut, UP, is hereby directed to comply with the following-

- I. the unit shall remain closed & shall resume manufacturing operation only after obtaining the valid consent to operate under Water Act & Air Act from UPPCB;
- II. the Unit shall immediately inform to CPCB after resumption of the manufacturing operations; and
- III. the Unit shall ensure all time compliance of the standards of treated effluent as per Gazette notification dated 10.10.2016 under Environment(Protection) Rules, 1986.
- IV. The unit shall submit treated effluent quality report from lab recognised under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to CPCB within 30 days of resumption of manufacturing operations.

In case of failure of the unit to comply with the directions, action will be taken in accordance with the provisions under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
