**Sub.: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986-reg (Show cause Notice).**

WHEREAS, the Pharmaceutical industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s. Alivira Animal Health Limited, Andhra Pradesh (herein after referred to as the Unit) which comes under pharmaceutical category, has installed online flow meter and web camera as the Online continuous effluent Monitoring system (OCEMS) as it is sending effluent to common effluent treatment plant (CETP); and

WHEREAS, it was observed by the IT division of the CPCB that the Online continuous effluent Monitoring system (OCEMS) of the Unit was in offline mode during the month of 15 May- 15 June 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by a team of official(s) from the CPCB Regional Directorate, Bangalore on July 18, 2017 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures and online effluent monitoring system observed as following:

- i. The Unit has not installed the water meter to measure the quantity of water consumed.
- ii. The Unit has installed three VOC sensors however all were not working on the day of inspection.
- iii. The Personal Protective Equipments are not provided to the workers/employees engaged in the manufacture of Active Pharmaceutical Ingredients (APIs).
- iv. The Unit has not provided the proper storage shed for hazardous waste.

WHEREAS, based upon observations of inspecting team & above mentioned non compliance a direction (show cause notice) was issued to the Unit on September 18, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Unit informed vide letter No. AAHL/CPCB/ENV/2017-2 dated October 03, 2017 that the Unit has taken corrective action with all the points of show cause notice dated September 18, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Unit vide above said letter dated October 03, 2017 submitted the undertaking duly notarized, Effluent monitoring laboratory analysis report, copy of consent valid upto March 31, 2019 and requested to revoke the direction (show cause notice); and

WHEREAS the Unit was again inspected by a team of official(s) from the RD, Bangalore on November 05, 2017 to assess the compliance status of the Unit w.r.t. show cause notice dated September 18, 2017; and

WHEREAS the Unit was found complying w.r.t. direction (show cause notice) dated September 18, 2017 during the inspection held on November 05, 2017; and


WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of powers vested to Chairman CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of compliance with relevant direction under reference, the direction (show cause notice) issued under the Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit **M/s. Alivira Animal Health Limited, Andhra Pradesh** vide letter dated September 18, 2017 is hereby revoked. In case of non-compliance by the Unit action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (P) Act, 1986 shall be taken.
