Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, the tannery and leather industries are also identified as one of the Grossly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly in to ambient Water and Air, having potential to threat to cause adverse effects on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s Zuric International, 377 D(A), Iqbal Street, Jajmau, Kanpur (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is a Tannery industry and was inspected by a team of officials authorized by CPCB on 04.04.2017 to verify the compliance status; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated June 22, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit ; and

WHEREAS, unit reply vide letter dated 12.08.2017 was examined & following observations were made:

1. The unit submitted the details of registration of the OCEMS with the CPCB portal and provided the connectivity with CPCB server.
2. The unit has submitted self-certificate regarding stoppage of all operations w.e.f. 11.07.2017.
3. The unit has submitted copies of consents issued under Water & Air Acts with validity upto 31.12.2017 and copy of Hazardous Waste authorization with validity upto 29.12.2017.

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WHEREAS, CPCB Constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, The Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 16/11/17 examined the replies dated, 12.08.2017 and 25.08.2017 and recommended for the revoke of the closure direction.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the show cause notice dated June 22, 2017 is hereby revoked and the unit is directed to comply with the following.

1. The unit shall ensure proper operation of PETP so as to achieve the prescribed standards and continuous transmission of data to CPCB.
2. The unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from E(P) act, 1986 recognised lab within 30 days after resumption of operation.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions or any other exigencies, CPCB will be constrained to initiate further stringent action against the unit (M/s Zuric International, 377 D(A), Iqbal Street, Jajmau, Kanpur), in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, without any further notice.
