Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 –reg.

WHEREAS, the central Government has notified standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under Rule 3 of the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 Whereas all industries are required to install and regularly operate the requisite pollution control facilities to comply with the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants; and

WHEREAS, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof ; and

WHEREAS, it was clarified that flow meter and web camera may be installed in case of units achieving zero liquid discharge ZLD by march 31, 2015 vide guidelines uploaded on website of CPCB dated November 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, M/s Allied Leather Finisher (P) Ltd. Unit-IV, A-38, LTP, UPSITC, Banther, Unnao, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is a Tannery industry and was inspected by a team of officials authorized by CPCB on 15.04.2017 to verify the compliance status; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued direction dated June 15th, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit to remain close and to complete OCEMS registration on CPCB portal; and

WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letter dated 20/07/2017, 02/08/2017 and 11/09/2017 were examined and following observations are made:

- i) The unit has completed its registration on CPCB portal.
- ii) Provided copy of air and water consent renewal application forwarded to UPPCB.
- iii) Provided copy of Authorization valid till 01/12/2017 issued by UPPCB under Hazardous Waste and Other Waste (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016
- iv) The unit has submitted the self-certificate, undertaking and treated effluent analysis report and PETP adequacy report to CPCB.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB Constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC & NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, The Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 21/11/17 examined the unit's replies dated 20/07/2017, 02/08/2017 and 11/09/2017 and recommended for the revoke of the closure direction

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure dated June 15th, 2017 issued to **M/s Allied Leather Finisher (P) Ltd. Unit-IV, A-38, LTP, UPSITC, Banther, Unnao, Uttar Pradesh** is hereby revoked and the unit is directed to comply the following directions:

1. The Unit, shall resume its manufacturing operation after obtaining valid consent under Water Act 1974 and Air Act 1981 from UPPCB.
2. The implementation status of the recommendations made by CLRI in the adequacy report (August 2016) shall be submitted by the unit within 45 days to CPCB.
3. The Unit shall submit treated effluent quality analysis report from recognised laboratory under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days after resume of operation.
4. Unit shall maintain logbook of Hazardous waste disposal to TSDF.
5. The Unit shall immediately inform to CPCB on resumption of manufacturing operation.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB may initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
