Sub.: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 regarding installation of on-line emission and effluent monitoring system- reg.

WHEREAS, Dye & Dye Intermediate units are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs) for installation of online effluent monitoring system w.r.t.. pH, TSS, BOD, COD, Cr, & Flow parameters in Dye & Dye Intermediate industries; and

WHEREAS, it was clarified that flow meter & web camera may be installed in case of Units with zero liquid discharge (ZLD) by March 31, 2015 vide guidelines uploaded on website of CPCB dated November 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Show Cause Notice under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986, was issued by Central pollution control board on July 29, 2015 to **M/s LML Dyes Industries, Plot No. 2017, Modern Industrial Estate, Bahadurgarh, Dist. Jhajjar, Haryana-124507** to show cause as to why the unit should not be closed down if, the unit has not complied fully with the directions issued w.r.t. installation of online effluent monitoring system by June 30, 2015. Further it was directed to submit documentary evidence regarding status of installation and connectivity; and

WHEREAS, the unit did not communicate completion of the installation and connectivity of the OCEMS and hence directions under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986, was issued by Central Pollution Control Board on April 07, 2016 to the unit to close down all operational activities with immediate effect till the connectivity of online effluent monitoring system is provided with the CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the unit vide Email dated December 14, 2017 submitted the details of connectivity of Online Monitoring System to CPCB, provided URL, User-id and Password for the online data view and requested to revoke the closure direction; and

WHEREAS, the connectivity of online data submitted by the unit was verified by the IT division, CPCB and compliance was observed on December 19, 2017 by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the unit has provided duly signed Self Certificate dated September 15, 2017; and

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 03.10.2017 having representative(s) from CPCB and MoEF&CC for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and


WHEREAS, the Three member committee in its meeting held on 05/01/2018 examined the compliance made by the Unit and recommended that the Unit may be allowed to restart operation; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested to chairman CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of compliance with relevant direction under reference, the directions issued under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the **M/s LML Dyes Industries, Plot No. 2017, Modern Industrial Estate, Bahadurgarh, Dist. Jhajjar, Haryana-124507** vide letter dated April 07, 2016 is hereby revoked; and

The Unit shall ensure compliance to the norms. In case of non-compliance observed by the Unit, action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (P) Act, 1986 shall be taken.
