Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, the tannery and leather industries are also identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly in to ambient Air and Water, having potential to threat to cause adverse effects on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s Sannu Enterprises (Sannu Tanning Industries),B-13, A Bhalla Estate, Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is a Tannery industry and was inspected by a team of officials authorized by CPCB on 25th March,2017 to verify the compliance status; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued Closure directions dated May 23rd, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit for not installing OCEMS; and

WHEREAS, the unit was re-inspected on 15th June, 2017 and was issued closure directions dated 23rd October,2017 for non-compliance of stipulated norms w.r.t total chromium (10.9 mg/l against stipulated standards of 2 mg/l);

AND WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters dated 27/07/2017, 10/08/2017, 26/08/2017, 06/09/2017 and 3/11/2017 were examined and following observations are made:

1. The unit has connected its Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS) with CPCB and has also completed its registration with CPCB portal.
2. The unit has also submitted the undertaking for compliance of CPCB directions.
3. The unit has installed screens at various places in its drains and chambers for the removal of T.S.S and Chromium.

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4. The unit has also submitted that it does not manufacture any product in which chromium is involved and the high chromium concentration might be the result of washing and oiling of split leather which already has a fixed quantity of chromium.

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF& CC & NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, The Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 21/11/2017 examined the replies dated 27/07/2017, 10/08/2017, 26/08/2017, 06/09/2017 and 3/11/2017 and recommended for the revoke of the closure direction.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure directions dated May 23rd, 2017 and October 23rd, 2017 are hereby revoked and the unit, **M/s Sannu Enterprises (Sannu Tanning Industries), B-13, A Bhalla Estate, Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh** is directed to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit shall ensure proper operation of the PETP so as to achieve the prescribed standards and continuous transmission of data to CPCB server.
2. The unit shall maintain log book for chromium sludge disposal.
3. UPPCB shall monitor disposal of chromium sludge to authorize TSDF site.
4. The unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from E (P) Act, 1986 recognized laboratory within 30 day of resumption of operation.
5. The unit shall resume operation only after obtaining valid consent from UPPCB.

In case of non-compliance of the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit without giving any further notice in accordance with the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
