**Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 –reg.**

**WHEREAS**, the **Textile** industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued direction dated 04.07.2017 under Section 5 of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986 to the M/s Jet Knitwears Ltd., 57-A Dada Nagar, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh, (herein after referred as the Unit) to close its operation immediately for non-compliance;

1. The unit shall augment ETP so that effluent quality meets the prescribed discharge standards
2. The unit shall provide treatment to the dyeing water in ETP.
3. The unit shall obtain valid hazardous waste authorization.
4. The unit shall installed OCEMS and provide connectivity for the effluent parameters pH, COD and TSS.

**AND WHEREAS**, the Unit replies vide letters dated 24.05.2017, 15.06.2017, 22.06.2017, 28.07.2017, 11.08.2017, 03.10.2017 and 21.11.2017 were examined and following observations are made;

1. The unit has stopped all the operation with effect from 26.05.2017 in compliance of closure direction issued by CPCB.
2. The unit has submitted the Self-Certificate and Self- Declaration as per CPCB format.
3. The unit has submitted consents under Air and Water Acts with validity upto 31.12.2018 and submitted applications for NOC to CGWA for water extraction as well as Hazardous Waste Authorization.
4. The unit has connected the OCEMS with CPCB server.
5. The unit has submitted the upgradation of ETP with installed Flash Mixer with Agitator, Air Blower for Equalization tank, Tube Settler and Media filled, online continuous dosing system, Media replace of Pressure Sand filter and activated carbon filter etc.

**AND WHEREAS**, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

**WHEREAS**, the three member committee in its meeting held on 22.11.2017 examined the replies dated 24.05.2017, 15.06.2017, 22.06.2017, 28.07.2017, 11.08.2017, 03.10.2017 and 21.11.2017 and recommended for revoke of closure direction dated 04.07.2017.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, the closure direction dated 04.07.2017 is revoked and the unit M/s Jet Knitweaves Ltd., 57-A Dada Nagar, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh is hereby directed to comply with the following directions;

1. The unit shall resume the manufacturing operation and inform immediately to CPCB; and
2. The Unit shall ensure all time compliance of the standards of treated effluent as per Gazette notification dated 10.10.2016 under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986; and
3. The Unit shall submit the treated effluent analysis report by the laboratory recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days from the date of resumption of operation.

In case of failure of the unit to comply with the directions, action will be taken in accordance with the provisions under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
