Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under;

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Shyam Lal Exports (Dyeing division), Harirampur, Aurai Road, Bhadohi, U.P. (here in after referred as 'the unit') is involved in the process of textile & dyeing; and.

WHEREAS, inspection of the unit was conducted on March 23rd, 2017 to check the status of compliance of prescribed norms; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated April 25th, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit for compliance of following directions:

- 1) The unit shall immediately discontinue practice of discharging untreated effluent to the nearby low lying area shall take immediate actions for removal of bypass arrangements.
- 2) The unit shall assess the impact of discharge of untreated effluent in the receiving environment, including groundwater quality and required remedial actions shall be taken.
- 3) The unit shall take required steps to make the existing ETP functional or to provide new ETP, so as to meet the stipulated standards for discharge of effluent.

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- 4) The unit shall install the required OCEMS at the ETP outlet and provide connectivity to SPCB/CPCB.
- 5) The unit shall provide required flow meters at the bore wells, ETP inlet & outlet and maintain records of fresh water consumption and waste water generation. CGWA permission, as per applicable rules shall be obtained for the withdrawal of groundwater.
- 6) The unit shall obtain valid authorization under the H.W (M, H & T.M.) Rules, 2008.

AND WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters dated 17/05/2017, 20/07/2017, 31/07/2017, 25/07/2017, 02/08/2017, 06/09/2017, 09/09/2017 and 11/09/2017 were examined and following observations are made:

- 1) The unit has installed OCEMS and connected it to CPCB server.
- 2) The unit has applied for CGWA NOC.
- 3) The unit has maintained its Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) for treatment of effluent generated. ETP system consists of Equalization tank, Primary settling, chemical dosing, aeration tank, and sand & carbon filters.
- 4) The unit has submitted an undertaking for compliance of CETP directions.
- 5) The unit has valid consent under Water/ Air acts with validity upto 31st December, 2017 and has applied for authorization under the Hazardous & other Wastes Rules, 2016.

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF& CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, The Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 21/11/2017 examined the replies dated 17/05/2017, 20/07/2017, 31/07/2017, 25/07/2017, 02/08/2017, 06/09/2017, 09/09/2017 and 11/09/2017 and recommended for the revoke of the closure direction.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure directions dated April 25th, 2017 issued to the unit, **M/s Shyam Lal Exports (Dyeing division), Harirampur, Aurai Road, Bhadohi, U.P.** are hereby revoked and the unit is directed to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit shall operate its ETP properly so as to achieve the prescribed standards and continuous transmission of data to CPCB server.
2. The unit shall submit a treated effluent analysis report to CPCB within 30 days of resumption of operation.

In case of non-compliance of the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit without giving any further notice in accordance with the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
