Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under;

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Bharat Handloom (Dyeing), Near Chak Mode, Vill. Sethpur, Dhaneshwar, Nehtaur, Bijnor -246733 (U.P.) (here in after referred as 'the unit') is involved in the process of dyeing; and

WHEREAS, inspection of the unit was conducted on April 7th, 2017 to check the status of compliance of prescribed norms; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 15th May, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for non-installation of OCEMS;

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 13th June, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for compliance of the following directions:

- 1) The unit shall immediately close down all the plant operations.
- 2) The unit shall report to CPCB regarding closure of manufacturing operations in compliance of the direction immediately on receipt of this direction.
- 3) The unit shall install the online effluent monitoring system and connect with CPCB server.
- 4) The unit shall obtain valid consent from UPPCB under Air and Water Acts.
- 5) After completion of the above said measures shall report to CPCB and seek permission from CPCB before resumption of their manufacturing operations.

AND WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters 17/07/2017, 20/09/2017 and 2/11/2017 were examined and following observations are made:

- 1) The unit has submitted ETP details and its feasibility report.
- 2) The unit has valid consent to operate under Water/ Air Acts upto 31/12/2018.
- 3) The unit has membership of TSDF facility with validity upto 25/09/2018.

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF& CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, The Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 15/11/2017 examined the replies dated 17/07/2017, 20/09/2017 and 2/11/2017 and recommended for the revoke of the closure direction.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the directions dated 15th May, 2017 and 13th June, 2017 are hereby revoked and the unit, **M/s Bharat Handloom (Dyeing), Near Chak Mode, Vill. Sethpur, Dhaneshwar, Nehtaur, Bijnor -246733 (U.P.)** is directed to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit shall operate its ETP properly so as to achieve the prescribed standards and continuous transmission of data to CPCB server.
2. The unit shall submit CPCB/SPCB report on the operation of ETP and treated effluent analysis report from E (P) Act, 1986 recognized laboratory within 30 days of starting of operation.
3. The unit shall immediately inform to CPCB on resumption of operation.

In case of non-compliance of the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit without giving any further notice in accordance with the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
