Revoking of closure direction under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries have been identified as one the Grossly Polluting Industries (GPI) which have been discharging effluents directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on land and the ambient water quality; and

WHEREAS, for strengthening the monitoring and compliance through self regulatory mechanism, online source emission and effluent monitoring systems need to be installed and operated by the industries on 'polluter pays principle'; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & control of pollution) Act, 1974 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all 11 Ganga Basin State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs)/Pollution Control Committee (PCC) for installation of online effluent monitoring system w.r.t. pH, BOD, TSS, COD and flow parameters in Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries; and

WHEREAS, it was clarified that flow meter & web camera may be installed in case of units with Zero Liquid Discharge (ZLD) by March 31, 2015 vide guidelines uploaded on website of CPCB dated November 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, considering the requests/representations received from industries/industrial associations /SPCBs/PCCS, an extension of time up to June 30, 2015 for installation of online monitoring systems was granted vide direction dated March 27, 2015 under section 18 (1) (b) of Water (Prevention & control of pollution) Act, 1974; and

WHEREAS, a letter vide dated May 29, 2015 was issued to the Chairman CPCB to all the SPCBs/PCCS informing that no further extension of time will be given after June 30, 2015 and withdrawal of consents to operate along with forfeiture of bank guarantee of non-complying Units will be the only option; and

WHEREAS, M/s Prakash Textiles, E-5, Site II, Panki Industrial Area, Kanpur, U.P. (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is a textile industry and was inspected by a team of officials authorized by CPCB on 03.04.2017 to verify the compliance status; and

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WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated June 29, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit ; and

WHEREAS, unit replies vide letters dated 8.09.2017, 11.09.2017 were examined & following observations are made:

1. The unit has submitted self-certificate regarding stoppage of all operations w.e.f. 30.06.2017 & provided the undertaking on the affidavit for close down the unit immediately till full compliance.
2. The unit has submitted the copy of application seeking consents under Water & Air Acts and copy of membership certificate from Bharat oil & Waste Management Ltd, for the disposal of Hazardous Waste.
3. The unit has submitted the copy of NOC from CGWA.

WHEREAS, CPCB Constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, The Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 22/11/17 examined the replies dated, 08.09.2017 and 18.09.2017 recommended the Unit to resume operation with the following condition

1. The unit shall start its operation only after obtaining valid consent from the concerned State Pollution Control Board.
2. The analysis result of the treated effluent shall also be submitted within 30 days through EPA recognised laboratories.
3. The unit shall submit the photograph of complete ETP with size & piping etc

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit is directed to comply with the following.

1. The unit shall start its operation only after obtaining valid consents under Water /Air Acts & authorization under the Hazardous & other Waste (Management Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rule, 2016.
2. The analysis result of the treated effluent shall also be submitted within 30 days through EPA recognised laboratories.
3. The unit shall submit the photograph of complete ETP with size & piping etc.
4. The unit shall report to CPCB immediately on resumption of operation.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions or any other exigencies, CPCB will be constrained to initiate further stringent action against the unit (M/s Prakash Textiles, E-5, Site II, Panki Industrial Area, Kanpur, U.P.), in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, without any further notice.
