Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 - Revoke reg.

WHEREAS, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and\

WHEREAS, M/s Pahlwan Tannery (Unit III), Plot No. 2- A/3, Gajjapurwa, Jajmau, Kanpur, UP (hereafter referred as the Unit), is a tannery engaged in processing of raw hides to produce finished leather; and

WHEREAS the unit was inspected by CPCB jointly on 23.05.2017 and made the following observations:-

- (i) ETP treated effluent sample was found non-complying w.r.t. the notified effluent discharge standards with TSS-660 mg/l (against norms of 600 mg/l), Chromium-20.3 mg/l (against norms 2.0 mg/l).
- (ii) The unit has not maintained log book for purchase of raw hides and finished production.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 10.08.2017 to the unit; and

WHEREAS, the Unit replies vide letters dated: 28.08.2017, 08.09.2017, 03.10.2017 and 16.10.2017 were examined and following observations made. The unit has submitted:-

- (i) The unit has informed that they had closed the production from 28.08.2017.
- (ii) The unit has submitted the status report along with the photographs regarding necessary steps taken to operate PETP properly to control the BOD and Oil/Grease values from PETP outlet within the Standards.
- (iii) The unit has submitted the undertaking on stamp paper in original in the prescribed format of CPCB.
- (iv) The unit has submitted a copy of online registration at CPCB Portal.
- (v) The unit has submitted self certificate in original in the prescribed format of CPCB.

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF &CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three member committee in its meeting held on 21.11.2017 examined the replies dated: 28.08.2017, 08.09.2017, 03.10.2017 and 16.10.2017 and recommended for the revoke of closure direction with the following conditions:-

1. The unit shall maintain log book for chromium bearing sludge disposal.
2. The unit shall submit analysis result of the treated effluent within 30 days from the date of resumption of operation through EPA recognized laboratories.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 the closure direction dated 10.08.2017 is hereby revoked and the Unit M/s Pahlwan Tannery (Unit III), Plot No. 2- A/3, Gajjupurwa, Jajmau, Kanpur, UP is permitted to resume manufacturing operations and directed to comply with the following:


- (i) The Unit will inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations.
- (ii) The unit shall maintain log book for chromium bearing sludge disposal.
- (iii) UPPCB shall monitor disposal of chromium bearing sludge to authorised TSDF site.
- (iv) The Unit shall submit analysis result of the treated effluent within 30 days from the date of resumption of operation through EPA recognized laboratories.
- (v) The Unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged by the Unit will comply the P-ETP standards / inlet to CETP standards and ensure regular compliance of prescribed norms in future as per CETP effluent standards notified by Central Government vide Gazette notification dated 01.01.2016 under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
