Directions Under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986- revoke reg.

WHEREAS, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, M/s Nagauri Tanning Industries, 102/88-A (3), Wajidpur, Jajmau, Kanpur, U.P. (hereafter referred as Unit) is a tannery engaged in processing of raw leather and wet blue leather to produce finished leather; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, the representative (s) of Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) carried out inspection of the unit on 06.04.2017 for verification of compliance to the norms stipulated under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and following observations were made:

- (i) The unit has no connectivity of the Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring system (OCEMS).
- (ii) Treated effluent discharge exceeding the limit w.r.t pH-3.5 (norms 6.5-9.0)
- (iii) Overall housekeeping of the plant was not properly managed.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB issued Closure direction dated 02.06.2017 under section 5 of the Environment (protection) Act, 1986 to the unit; and

WHEREAS, the Unit has submitted reply on 25.09.2017 was examined and following observations are made:

- i. The unit has installed OCEMS and connected to CPCB portal.

- ii. The unit has submitted PETP Adequacy Assessment report prepared by National Productivity Council, Kanpur in August, 2017.
- iii. The unit has received authorization (valid upto 08.05.2022) under Hazardous and other Wastes Rules, 2016.
- iv. The unit has membership of Uttar Pradesh Waste Management Project and submitted a copy of membership.
- v. The unit has submitted undertaking and self-certificate wherein the unit has informed the stoppage of all the operation with effect from 19.06.2017.

WHEREAS, CPCB Constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, The Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 22/11/17 examined the replies dated 25.09.2017 and recommended for the revoke of the closure directions with the following conditions:-

- I. The unit shall implement recommendations of Adequacy Report.
- II. The unit shall submit treated effluent quality analysis report from recognised laboratory under the Environment Protection act 1986 within 30 days after resume of operation.
- III. The unit shall maintain the log-book for Hazardous Waste disposal to TSDF.

AND NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure direction dated 02.06.2017 issued to **M/s Nagauri Tanning Industries, 102/88-A (3), Wajidpur, Jajmau, Kanpur, U.P.** is hereby revoked and the unit is directed to comply with the following direction:

1. The Unit shall immediately inform to CPCB on resumption of manufacturing process.
2. The unit shall implement recommendations of Adequacy Report.
3. The unit shall submit treated effluent quality analysis report from recognised laboratory under the Environment Protection act 1986 within 30 days from resume of operation.
4. The unit shall maintain the log-book for Hazardous Waste disposal to TSDF.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate action without any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
