Sub.: Direction issued under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986- Revoke reg.

WHEREAS, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under Rule 3 of the Environmental (Protection) Rules, 1986; and

WHEREAS, all industries are required to install and regularly operate the requisite pollution control facilities to comply with the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, inspection of M/s Nusrat Tannery Pvt. Ltd., a tannery located at 22/19, Gajjupurwa, Jajmau, Kanpur U.P., (here in after referred as the Unit), a member unit of Jajmau CETP, was carried out on 03.04.2017 and the Unit was found closed on the day of inspection; and

WHEREAS, CBCB issued closure direction dated 18.05.2017, under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; to the Unit, to close all operations immediately in view of non installation of OCEMS along with the connectivity to CPCB server; and

WHEREAS, the unit reply vide their letters dated: 09.10.2017 and 27.10.2017 were examined and the following observations are made.

- (i) The Unit has informed that they have installed OCEMS, found connected and submitted a copy of registration on CPCB website.
- (ii) The Unit has submitted self certificate as per office order 21.07.2017.

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WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF &CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three member committee in its meeting held on 15.11.2017 examined the replies dated: 09.10.2017 and 27.10.2017 and recommended for the revoke of closure direction with the following condition:-

1. The unit shall submit effluent analysis report to CPCB within 30 days from resumption of the operations from an EPA recognised laboratory.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, the Closure direction dated 18.05.2017 is revoked and the unit M/s Nusrat Tannery Pvt. Ltd. 22/19, Gajjipurwa, Jajmau, Kanpur, U.P., is hereby directed to comply with the following:-

- (i) The unit may resume manufacturing operation and inform the same to CPCB immediately.
- (ii) The Unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged by the Unit will comply the PETP standards / inlet to CETP standards as per UPPCB and the effluent discharged by the Unit is further treated in the CETP as per CETP effluent standards notified by Central Government vide Gazette notification dated 01.01.2016 under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.
- (iii) The unit shall submit effluent analysis report to CPCB within 30 days from resumption of the operation from an EPA recognised laboratory.

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
