Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 - Revoke reg.

WHEREAS, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent & emission monitoring devices, mechanical system for chemical dosing and sludge dewatering to avoid human errors and get the consistent results; and

WHEREAS, M/s Hides International limited, (old name- K.C.K. Export Ltd.) (here in after referred as 'the Unit') located at 461, Fatehpur Roshnai, Rania, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh, is a tannery unit involved in the process of raw hides to finished leather; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected on 08.03.2017, by officials of Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB); and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected on 27.04.2017, by the team deputed by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 21.06.2017 to the unit and directed that -

1. The Unit shall close down all the manufacturing operations with immediate effect.
2. The Unit shall report to CPCB regarding closure of operations in compliance of the direction immediately on receipt of this direction.
3. The Unit shall obtain valid consent from UPPCB under Water and Air Acts.
4. The Unit shall obtain authorization for disposal of hazardous waste.
5. The Unit shall report to CPCB and seek permission from CPCB before resumption of their manufacturing operations.

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AND WHEREAS, CPCB issued show cause notice dated 29.06.2017 and directed to the unit to comply with the following directions within 30 days-

1. The Unit shall submit the adequacy assessment report from CLRI, on existing ZLD system consisting of RO, single evaporator system, ETP & CRP system to CPCB.
2. The Unit shall install electromagnetic flow meter at bore well(s) for measuring fresh water withdrawal.
3. The Unit shall maintain log book for flow meter installed at ETP inlet and operation of CRP for treatment of chrome liquor.
4. The Unit shall repair the damaged drain for collecting chrome liquor in order to prevent the leakage of untreated effluent.
5. The Unit shall provide details/information on alternative arrangement to achieve ZLD condition in case of repair/ maintenance of RO and / pre-treatment system.

WHEREAS, the unit's replies vide letters dated 04.07.2017, 26.07.2017, 03.08.2017, 10.08.2017, 21.09.2017, were examined and the following observations are made-

1. The Unit has submitted Adequacy Report of Effluent Treatment and ZLD system. The adequacy report prepared by M/s Environmental Engineering Consultant (508, Dwarakamai Apartments, Navodaya Colony, Post Srinagar Colony, Hyderabad) and vetted by Dr. Shashidhar, IIT Hyderabad.
2. The Unit has installed OCEMS and provided connectivity with CPCB server.
3. The Unit has submitted self certificate mentioning that they had stopped the operations w.e.f. 30/06/2017 in compliance of the closure directions issued by the CPCB.
4. The Unit has submitted notarized Affidavit dated 05.09.2017, in the required format.
5. The Unit has Consent to operate (valid upto 31.12.2018) under Water Act and Air Act and
6. The unit has authorization under Hazardous Waste (Management and Handling) Rules.
7. The Unit has installed Flow Meter at bore well (water source) and submitted copy of log book

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted Three Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, The Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 21/11/17 examined the replies dated 04.07.2017, 26.07.2017, 03.08.2017, 10.08.2017, 21.09.2017 and recommended for the revoke of the closure direction.

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NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure direction dated 21.06.2017 and the show cause notice dated 29.06.2017 are revoked and the unit M/s Hides International Ltd., 461, Fatehpur Roshnai, Rania, Kanpur Dehat, Uttar Pradesh, is hereby directed to comply with the following-

1. Unit shall always ensure the ZLD conditions, as mentioned in the consent dated 24/05/2017, under Water Act 1974, issued by the Uttar Pollution Control Board.
2. To maintain logbook of Hazardous waste chrome bearing sludge disposal to TDSF site.
3. Unit will inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations.
4. The unit shall submit treated effluent (before RO feed) analysis report from laboratory recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, within 30 days of resumption of the unit.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, the CPCB may initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
