Sub.: Direction issued under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986- Revoke reg.

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s Shakti Dyeing and Bleaching Works, (Super Dying and Bleaching) (here in after referred as the Unit), is located at 16 A, Dada Nagar, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh; and

WHEREAS, Inspection of the unit was conducted on 10.04.2017, by Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) to check the compliance. The inspection report was examined and the following observations are made:-

- (i) ETP treated effluent sample was found non-complying w.r.t. the notified effluent discharge standards with BOD-42 mg/l (against norms of 30 mg/l), SAR-109.17 (against norms of 26), Sulphate as S- 16mg/l (against norms of 2 mg/l).
- (ii) The Unit has not installed online effluent monitoring system.
- (iii) The flow meter at Intel of ETP was not installed. However, at Outlet, flow meter was installed but not in working condition;
- (iv) The unit has not obtained authorization for disposal of Hazardous Waste;
- (v) The unit has not obtained permission from CGWA for extraction of ground water and the logbook of the same was not maintained.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, CBCB issued direction dated 29.06.2017, to close down operation with immediate effect till compliance with the prescribed effluent discharge standards; and installation and commissioning of online 24x7 monitoring system and connectivity of data to with SPCB and CPCB, and

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WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters dated 16.08.2017, 29.08.2017 and 08.10.2017 were examined the following observation are made:-

- (i) It has installed OCEMS and provided User ID, URL, Password etc. and
- (ii) The unit has valid consent for trade effluent discharge 2KL/day, valid up to 31.12.2021 under Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act issued by the Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board; and
- (iii) The unit has installed ETP system with the revised treatment strategy, more reliable and efficient chemical dosing.

WHEREAS, CPCB Constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, The Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 21/11/2017 examined the replies dated 16.08.2017, 29.08.2017 & 08.10.2017 and recommended for the revoke of the closure direction.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, the closure directions dated 29.06.2017 is revoked and the unit M/s Shakti Dyeing and Bleaching Works, (Super Dying and Bleaching) 16 A, Dada Nagar, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh, is permitted to resume the production and hereby directed to comply with the following conditions:-

- (i) The unit shall immediately inform to the CPCB on resumption of operation; and.
- (ii) The unit shall submit effluent analysis report to CPCB within 30 days from resuming the operation from an EPA recognised laboratory.
- (iii) The Unit shall not discharge any untreated / partially treated effluent and shall ensure all time compliance of the standards of treated effluent for Textile industries as per Gazette notification dated 10.10.2016 under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.

In case of failure of the unit to comply with the directions, action will be taken in accordance with the provisions under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
