Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986-reg.

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s J.S. Fabrics, (hereafter referred as the Unit), is a textile industry located at Lot No. 658, 659 and 660, Magarwara, Unnao, Uttar Pradesh; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected by CPCB officials on 24-03-2017 and following observation were made:

1. The unit has not installed Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS).
2. During the visit, ETP was not operational and effluent being generated is collected in 02 nos. of receiving tanks. Possibility of discharge/ bypass of untreated effluent cannot be ruled out as ETP was not operational.
3. The unit does not have NOC from CGWA for ground water abstraction.
4. The stack height of DG is not adequate.

WHEREAS, CBCB issued closure direction dated 15.05.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; to the Unit to close down till installation of online continuous effluent monitoring system (OCEMS) and connectivity with CPCB/SPCB; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 18.05.2017 under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to the unit ; and

WHEREAS, the unit reply vide letters dated 10-06-2017, 11-07-2017, 12-09-2017, 09-10-2017, 01-11-2017 & 20-11-2017 were examined and the following observation were made-

- i) the unit has installed OCEMS and provided connectivity with CPCB server.
- ii) the unit has submitted self certificate mentioning that it has stopped the operations with effect from 10.06.2017.
- iii) the unit has submitted notarized Affidavit dated 08.11.2017.
- iv) the unit has submitted copy of applied application for obtaining NOC to CGWA for extraction of ground water.
- v) the unit has installed flow meter at bore well and ETP outlet.
- vi) the unit has consent (valid up to 31.12.2017) for trade effluent discharge of 12KL/day, under the Water Act 1974, issued by the Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board.
- vii) the unit has ETP system consisting of Receiving tank, equalization and neutralization tank, aeration tank, secondary clarifier, sump, flash mixer, tube settler, dual media filter, activated carbon filter and sludge drying bed.

WHEREAS, CPCB Constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, NMCG & MoEF&CC for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, The Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 22/11/17 examined the replies dated 10-06-2017, 11-07-2017, 12-09-2017, 09-10-2017, 01-11-2017 & 20-11-2017 and recommended for the revoke of the closure directions dated 15-05-2017 and 18-05-2017 with the following condition-

- the unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, within 30 days from resumption of operations.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, the closure directions dated 15-05-2017 and 18.05.2017 are revoked and the unit M/s J.S. Fabrics, Lot No. 658, 659 and 660, Magarwara, Unnao, Uttar Pradesh, is hereby directed to comply with the following-

- I. the Unit may resume manufacturing operation and shall immediately inform to CPCB after resumption of the manufacturing operations;
- II. the unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report by the EPA recognized laboratory within 30 days from the resuming operation, and
- III. the Unit shall ensure all time compliance of the standards of treated effluent as per Gazette notification dated 10.10.2016 under Environment(Protection) Rules, 1986.

In case of failure of the unit to comply with the directions, action will be taken in accordance with the provisions under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
