**Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986- Revoke reg.**

**WHEREAS**, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Nikhil India Cotton Industries, (hereafter referred as the Unit), is a textile industry located at E-52, Site-1, Unnao, Uttar Pradesh; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit was inspected by deputed officials of IIT, BHU on 11-04-2017 and observed the following:

1. The unit has not installed Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS).
2. The unit does not meet the prescribed norms for treated effluent for textile industries
3. Multiple discharges and bypass of effluent was observed during the inspection.

**WHEREAS**, CBCB issued closure direction dated 15.05.2017, under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; to the Unit to close down till installation of online continuous effluent monitoring system (OCEMS) and connectivity with CPCB/SPCB; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued closure direction dated 07-07-2017 under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to the unit; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit was re-inspected on 28-06-2017 and was found closed in compliance with CPCB closure directions dated 15.05.2017 and 07-07-2017, issued under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit reply vide letters dated 29.08.2017 was examined and the following observation are made-

- i) The unit has installed OCEMS, provided connectivity with CPCB server.
- ii) The unit has submitted self certificate mentioning that it has stopped the operations with effect from 20.06.2017.
- iii) The unit has submitted notarized Affidavit dated 31.08.2017.
- iv) The unit has consent (valid up to 31.12.2017) for trade effluent discharge of 8KL/day, under the Water Act 1974, issued by the Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board.
- v) The unit has ETP system consisting of Equalization tank, reaction tank, primary aeration tank, secondary aeration tank and carbon filter.

**WHEREAS**, CPCB Constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

**WHEREAS**, The Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 21/11/17 examined the replies dated 29.08.2017 and recommended for the revoke of the closure direction.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, the closure directions dated 15-05-2017 and 07.07.2017 are revoked and the unit M/s Nikhil India Cotton Industries E-52, Site-1, Unnao, Uttar Pradesh is hereby directed to comply with the following-


- I.** The Unit may resume the manufacturing operations and shall immediately inform to CPCB;
- II.** The Unit shall ensure all time compliance of the standards of treated effluent as per Gazette notification dated 10.10.2016 under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.
- III.** The unit shall submit treated effluent quality analysis report from lab recognised under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days of resumption of operations.

In case of failure of the unit to comply with the directions, action will be taken in accordance with the provisions under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
