**Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 – Revoke reg.**

**WHEREAS**, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Shakun Handifab Private Limited, (hereafter referred as the Unit), is a Textile industry located at Partapur, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit was inspected on April 03, 2017, by representatives of CPCB and it was observed that the unit has no connectivity of the online continuous Effluent monitoring system (OCEMS) and Treated Effluent discharge exceeding the limit; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued closure direction dated 15.05.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit for installation & providing connectivity of online continuous effluent monitoring system to CPCB server and;

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued closure direction dated 20.06.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; to the Unit, to close down till registration of online monitoring system and connectivity with CPCB/UPPCB server and compliance with the treated effluent discharge and;

**WHEREAS**, the unit's reply vide letter dated 21.09.2017, 03.10.2017, 01.11.2017 were examined and the following observations are made-

- (i) Unit has registered OCEMS, provided connectivity with CPCB server.
- (ii) Unit has submitted undertaking and self-certificate and analysis report of final effluent of ETP.

**AND WHEREAS**, CPCB Constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

**WHEREAS**, The Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 22.11.2017 examined the replies dated 21.09.2017, 03.10.2017, 01.11.2017 recommended for the revoke of the closure direction with the following conditions:-

1. The Unit shall submit treated effluent quality analysis report from recognised laboratory under the Environment Protection act 1986 within 30 days after resume of operation.
2. The Unit shall submit ETP unit's sizes and photographs of all the units.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, the closure directions dated 15.05.2017 & 20.06.2017 are hereby revoked and M/s Shakun Handifab Private Limited, Partapur, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh is hereby directed to comply with the following-

1. The unit may resume manufacturing operations.
2. The Unit shall submit treated effluent quality analysis report from recognised laboratory under the Environment Protection act 1986 within 30 days after resume of operation.
3. The Unit shall submit ETP unit's sizes and photographs of all the units.
4. The unit shall immediately inform to CPCB on resumption of manufacturing operations.

In case of failure of the unit to comply with the directions, action will be taken in accordance with the provisions under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
