

Minimal National Standards for Liquid Effluent -Paint Industry

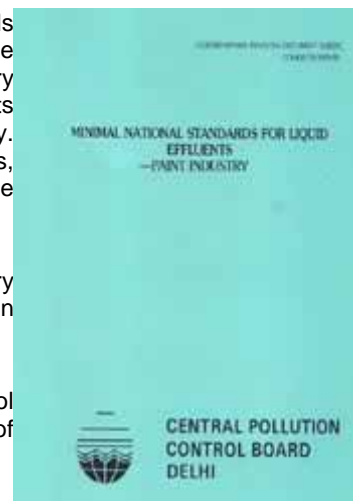
Foreword

Industrial units manufacturing paint are only few in the country but thousands of Small Scale units are scattered throughout the country. In absence of the industry-specific standards, difficulties are often faced by the regulatory agencies to prescribe relevant consent conditions and by industries/consultants in design and installation of appropriate pollution control devices for the industry. In the present document Minimal National Standards (MINAS) for wastewaters, control measures for emissions and guidelines for solid waste disposal for the paint industry are provided.
