**Sub.: Direction under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986- Revoke reg.**

**Whereas**, the Central Government has notified standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under Rule 3 of the Environmental (Protection) Rules, 1986; and

**Whereas**, all industries are required to install and regularly operate the requisite pollution control facilities to comply with the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants; and

**Whereas**, inspection of M/s Iqbal Leathers Pvt. Ltd., Plot No C-2, Site-II, Industrial Area, Unnao, U.P., (hereafter referred as Unit) a member unit of Kanpur CETP, was carried out on 31-05-2017, and observed the following:

1. the unit was found non-complying the prescribed PETP outlet/ CETP inlet limits prescribed by UPPCB. i.e. Total Chromium: 2.83 mg/l (Limit.:2.0 mg/l).
2. The unit was operated without valid consents of water & Air Act, 1974.

**AND Whereas**, CPCB issued directions dated 31-08-2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to the Unit M/s Iqbal Leathers Pvt. Ltd., Plot No C-2, Site-II, Industrial Area, Unnao, U.P., to comply with the following direction;

1. The unit shall submit the PETP adequacy assessment report to CPCB duly validated by reputed institutions like Central Leather Research Institute (CLRI), National Productivity Council (NPC), IITs etc.
2. The unit shall obtain the valid consents under Water & Air Acts, and authorization under Hazardous and other waste Rule, 2016 from UPPCB.

**AND WHEREAS**, the unit reply vide letters dated 29-09-2017, 24-10-2017 and 06-11-2017 were examined and the following observation were made-

- i) the unit has submitted adequacy report of PETP prepared by IIT, Kanpur in February, 2014 and compliance status of recommendation made in Adequacy report on PETP validated by IIT, Kanpur in March, 2017, which were examined
- ii) the unit has installed OCEMS and provided connectivity with CPCB server.
- iii) the unit has submitted self certificate mentioning that it has stopped the operations with effect from 19.09.2017.
- iv) the unit has submitted notarized Affidavit dated 06.11.2017.
- v) the unit has provide a copy of application (20-03-2017) seeking consent for trade effluent discharge under the Water Act 1974, to the Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board.
- vi) the unit has ETP system consisting of coarse bar screen, equalization tank, mechanical rotary screen, holding tank, dosing and mixing tank, clarifier I, clarifier II, collection tank-I, collection tank II, plate and frame filter press and sludge drying beds.

**AND WHEREAS**, CPCB Constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, NMCG & MoEF&CC for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

**WHEREAS**, The Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 22/11/17 examined the replies dated 29-09-2017, 24-10-2017 and 06-11-2017 and recommended for the revoke of the closure direction dated 31-08-2017 with the following condition-

1. The unit shall submit ETP Adequacy report (fresh 2017) within 30 days from resumption of operations.
2. The unit shall obtain CTO (valid) before starting operation.
3. The unit shall submit unit wise photographs of complete ETP with sizes with sizes and piping etc.
4. The unit should maintained log book for hazardous sludge disposal at TSDF.

**Now therefore**, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 the Closure directions dated 31-08-2017 is hereby revoked and the Unit- M/s Iqbal Leathers Pvt. Ltd., Plot No C-2, Site-II, Industrial Area, Unnao, U.P, is permitted to resume manufacturing operations and directed to comply with the following:

- I.** The unit shall remain closed & shall resume manufacturing operation only after obtaining the valid consent to operate under Water Act & Air Act from UPPCB.
- II.** The Unit shall immediately inform to CPCB on resumption of the manufacturing operations.
- III.** The Unit shall ensure that the primary treated effluent discharged by the Unit is further treated in the CETP as per CETP effluent standards notified by Central Government vide Gazette notification dated 01.01.2016 under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.
- IV.** The unit shall submit ETP Adequacy report (fresh 2017) within 30 days from resumption of operations.
- V.** The unit shall submit unit wise photographs of complete ETP with sizes with sizes and piping etc.
- VI.** The unit should maintained log book for hazardous sludge disposal at TSDF.

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.


