Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 -reg.

WHEREAS, the Petrochemical industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, CPCB has issued a notice u/s 5 of the E(P) Act, 1986 on July 24, 2015 to M/s Maharashtra Polybutenes Limited, Plot No.- R-802, TTC Industrial Area, MIDC Mahape, Navi Mumbai- 400701 Maharashtra (herein after referred as the Unit) to install online monitoring system and provide connectivity; and

WHEREAS, CPCB has issued reminder letter dated October 13, 2015 to the Unit regarding installation of Online Effluent & Emission Monitoring System

WHEREAS, the Unit replied letter dated October 26, 2015 informed that since last three years the plant was in operation for only 72 days due to shortage of raw material and the Unit was under shutdown from 26.05.15 and requested to give at least 06 months to install the online monitoring system; and

WHEREAS, CPCB has again issued reminder letter dated February 03, 2016 to the Unit regarding installation of Online Effluent & Emission Monitoring System at the Unit and submit the documentary evidence for the same, failure to which the Unit will be issued closure direction; and

WHEREAS, the Unit replied letter dated February 22, 2016 informed that since last three years the plant was in operation for only 72 days due to shortage of raw material and requested to give at least 12 months to install the online monitoring system; and

WHEREAS, a closure direction u/s 5 of E(P) Act, 1986 vide letter B-29016/04/06/PCI-1/5896 dated July 21, 2016 has issued to the Unit regarding installation of On-line effluent & emission monitoring system; and

WHEREAS, the Unit letter dated January 04, 2017 informed that the Unit is not a Petrochemicals Industry and does not fall under the list of 17 Industries with a request to revoke the closure direction u/s 5 of E(P) Act, 1986 dated July, 21, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board (MPCB) informed vide letter No. MPCB/AS(T)/B-4502 dated November 01, 2017 that the Unit is manufacturing Polybutane and does not fall under the list of 17 categories of highly polluting industries and recommended for withdrawal of closure direction dated July 21, 2016 issued to the Unit; and

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 03.10.2017 having representative(s) from CPCB and MoEF&CC for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three member committee in its meeting held on 30.11.2017 examined the reply of Maharashtra Pollution Control Board and recommended the exemption of installation of Online effluent/ emission monitoring system administratively; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, based on all material facts available with CPCB and in exercise of powers vested under Section-5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the direction issued under the Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit [M/s Maharashtra Polybutenes Limited, TTC Industrial Area, MIDC Mahape, Navi Mumbai, Maharashtra] vide letter dated July 21, 2016 is hereby revoked.
