

Minimal National Standards Dye and Dye Intermediate Industry

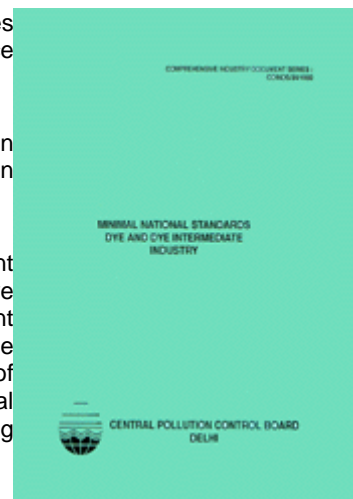
Foreword
