Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, the tannery and leather industries are also identified as one of the Grossly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly in to ambient Water and Air, having potential to threat to cause adverse effects on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s Gajala Tannery, 189/172, Jajmau, Kanpur (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is a Tannery industry and was inspected by a team of officials authorized by CPCB on 04.05.2017 to verify the compliance status; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated June 13, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit ; and

WHEREAS, unit's reply vide letters dt nil, received on 1.08.2017, and dated 16.11.2017 were examined & following observation are made:

1. The unit submitted the details of registration of the OCEMS with the CPCB portal and provided the connectivity with CPCB server.
2. The unit has submitted copy of consents under the Water & Air Acts with validity till 31.12.2017 and authorization under the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rule, 2016 having validity for 5 years since 20.12.2016.
3. The unit has upgrade the PETP with the increased depth of settling tank and also increased the amount of chemical dosing.
4. The unit has submit PETP adequacy report dated 10.11.2017, the PETP is adequate for treatment of effluent upto 18.35 KL

AND WHEREAS, CPCB Constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, The Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 30/11/17 examined the reply dated, 16.11.2017 and recommended the Unit to resume operation with the following condition

- 1.. The unit shall resume its operation only after obtaining valid consent from the concerned State Pollution Control Board.
2. The analysis result of the treated effluent shall be submitted within 30 days from the date of resumption of operation through EPA recognised lab.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure direction dated June 13, 2017 is hereby revoked and the unit is directed to comply with the following.

1. The unit shall remain closed and shall resume its operation only after obtaining valid consent from the Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board.
2. The unit shall ensure proper operation of PETP so as to achieve the prescribed standards and continuous transmission of data to CPCB.
3. The analysis result of the treated effluent shall be submitted within 30 days from the date of resumption of operation through EPA recognised lab.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions or any other exigencies, CPCB will be constrained to initiate further stringent action against the unit (M/s Gajala Tannery, 189/172, Jajmau, Kanpur), in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, without any further notice.
