**DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986**

**WHEREAS**, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and other standards and norms; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Sahota Papers Ltd., Vill- Narayanpur, Post- Jaspur, Opp- K.P. School, Kashipur (Udham Singh Nagar) Uttarakhand (hereinafter referred as 'the Unit') is a waste paper based mill and engaged in Duplex board, Poster, Kraft Paper with an installed capacity of 175 TPD; and

**WHEREAS**, the Unit was inspected by the officials of CPCB on **December 22, 2016** and following observations were made:

1. The unit is engaged in production of Duplex coated board (160 TPD) waste paper as raw material.
2. Unit has consent under Water & Air Act, valid up-to 31.03.2017.
3. The unit has provided OCEMS connectivity on CPCB server.
4. The unit has installed flow meter on all the three bore wells.
5. Waste water originating from canteen was being discharged through another separate drain.
6. During inspection the boiler blow down water (hot) was being discharged through separate drain other than the main outlet.
7. The unit has upgraded the ETP up-to tertiary level.
8. The ETP treated effluent sample results was found non complying with respect to **TSS- 57 mg/l** (as against the norms of 50 mg/l) and **BOD- 43 mg/l** (as against the norms of 30 mg/l); and

**WHEREAS**, the unit was issued show cause notice dated 13.01.2017 under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

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**WHEREAS,** the units reply vide letter dated 09.02.2017 was examined; and

**WHEREAS,** the Unit was inspected by the officials of CPCB on **July 13, 2017** and made following observations are made:

- The unit & ETP both were operational on the day of inspection. The unit is engaged in production of Duplex Board with installed capacity of 175 TPD and production using waste paper as raw material.
- The unit meets fresh water demand from 03 numbers of bore well installed with water meter. The fresh water consumption of the unit is 14.5 KL/MT for the month of June, 2017 and waste water generation is 9.68 KL/MT of product.
- The treated effluent of the unit is discharged in local drain to Dehla river which meets river Ramganga.
- OCEMS is installed in the unit and is connected with CPCB server.
- The unit has valid consent under Air Act, Water Act & Hazardous waste Authorization up to 31.03.2018.
- The ETP of the unit is upgraded up to tertiary treatment (DMF) facility. The unit has installed water meter on recycling point.
- Analysis report of ETP treated effluent shows : pH 7.51 ; **BOD- 35 mg/l** (as against the norms of 30mg/l); COD- 101 mg/l (as against the norms of 250 mg/l); TSS-31 mg/l (as against the norms of 50 mg/l).

**AND NOW, THEREFORE,** in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the notice is hereby served to the **unit M/s Sahota Papers Ltd., Kashipur (Udham Singh Nagar) Uttarakhand** to **Show Cause, Why the unit should not be closed.**

You are hereby given an opportunity to file your objection (if any) to the above proposed direction within 15 days from the receipt of this notice, failing which appropriate action will be taken against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

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
