**Closure Direction under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986**

**WHEREAS**, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries have been identified as one the Grossly Polluting Industries (GPI) which have been discharging effluents directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on land and the ambient water quality; and

**WHEREAS**, for strengthening the monitoring and compliance through self regulatory mechanism, online source emission and effluent monitoring systems need to be installed and operated by the industries on 'polluter pays principle'; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & control of pollution) Act, 1974 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all 11 Ganga Basin State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs)/Pollution Control Committee (PCC) for installation of online effluent monitoring system w.r.t. pH, BOD, TSS, COD and flow parameters in Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries; and

**WHEREAS**, it was clarified that flow meter & web camera may be installed in case of units with Zero Liquid Discharge (ZLD) by March 31, 2015 vide guidelines uploaded on website of CPCB dated November 7, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, considering the requests/representations received from industries/industrial associations /SPCBs/PCCS, an extension of time up to June 30, 2015 for installation of online monitoring systems was granted vide direction dated March 27, 2015 under section 18 (1) (b) of Water (Prevention & control of pollution) Act, 1974; and

**WHEREAS**, a letter vide dated May 29, 2015 was issued to the Chairman CPCB to all the SPCBs/PCCS informing that no further extension of time will be given after June 30, 2015 and withdrawal of consents to operate along with forfeiture of bank guarantee of non-complying Units will be the only option; and

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WHEREAS, M/s Pratik Arts, D3, D4, Industrial Estate, Thandhi Sadak, Farrukhbad, (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is a textile industry and was inspected by a team of officials authorized by CPCB on 16.10.2017 to verify the compliance. The following observations were made by the team:

1. The Unit was operational at the time of inspection.
2. The unit has not installed online effluent monitoring system at the outlet of ETP.
3. The unit has not maintained the logbook of ETP operation, fresh water consumption.
4. The unit has not obtained the permission from CGWA for abstraction of ground water.
5. Analysis of treated effluent shows pH-9.67 (against norms of 6.5-8.5), BOD-29.5mg/l (against norms of 30mg/l), SS-158 mg/l (against norms of 100 mg/l), TDS - 1076 mg/l (against norms of 2100 mg/l), COD- 126 mg/l (against norms of 250 mg/l), Color- 250 Hazen (against norms of 150 PCU), Sulphide- BDL (against norms of 2.0 mg/l), which indicates non-compliance with the prescribed effluent discharge norms under E (P) Act, 1986.

It is evident from the above observations that the Unit discharges partially /untreated effluent into river Ganga which posing potential threat to the water quality of River Ganga.

**AND NOW, THEREFORE,** in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions are issued to M/s Pratik Arts, D3, D4, Industrial Estate, Thandhi Sadak, Farrukhbad for compliance,

1. The Unit shall close down all manufacturing operation immediately.
2. The Unit shall install Online Effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS) and provide connectivity with the CPCB server.
3. The Unit shall upgrade ETP system so as to comply with the notified effluent discharge standards and shall submit the ETP adequacy report prepared by reputed institute to CPCB.
4. The Unit shall report to CPCB regarding closure of manufacturing operations in compliance of the direction immediately on receipt of this direction.
5. The Unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of any manufacturing operations.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions or any other exigencies, CPCB will be constrained to initiate further stringent action against the unit (M/s Pratik Arts, D3,D4, Industrial Estate, Thandhi Sadak, Farrukhbad,), in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, without any further notice.


