Closure Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 –reg.

WHEREAS, the Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self-monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent & emission monitoring devices; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s. Jaibeer Yadav, Ganesh Prasad Street (Chamcha Wali Gali), Narkasha, Farrukhabad, Uttar Pradesh, (herein after referred as the Unit) is involved in the processing of hosiery clothes; and

WHEREAS, inspection of the unit was conducted on 16.10.2017 by a team of CPCB officials and following observations are made:

1. At the time of inspection the unit was found operational.
2. No sign board was found at the entrance of the unit.
3. The unit has not provided any copy of consent to inspecting team and it was informed that the unit has yet not applied to obtain consent under Water and Air Acts from UPPCB.
4. The unit is cottage industry having dyeing pot installed at the residence and the domestic electric and water connection is being used for the unit operation.
5. The unit has also provided one genset of 5 KVA capacity for power backup. But the DG set provided was not having any enclosure or stack as per the guideline.
6. The unit has not provided any ETP facility and wastewater generated during process is directly discharged into the sewerage without any treatment.
7. The wastewater samples could not be collected as the wastewater was not discharged by the unit at the time of visit.

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit is hereby directed to stop all manufacturing operations immediately till compliance of following directions.

1. The unit should obtain valid consents from UPPCB.
2. The unit should installed proper indicator/ sign board containing mane of the unit and occupier and other related details at the entrance of the unit.
3. The unit should install appropriate and separate adequate Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) facility to meet out of prescribed discharge norms.
4. The unit should install Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS) and provide connectivity with CPCB server.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions CPCB may initiate appropriate actions against the unit, M/s. Jaibeer Yadav, Ganesh Prasad Street (Chamcha Wali Gali), Narkasha, Farrukhabad, Uttar Pradesh, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
