**Sub.: Revocation of Closure Directions issued under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 regarding Non-connectivity of on-line effluent and emission monitoring system.**

*Ref.: Letter No. B-33014/3/2017/IPC-II/1486, dated 06.04.2017 (dispatched on 22.04.2017)*

WHEREAS, integrated steel plants and sponge iron-units are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality;

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under;

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self-monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent and emission monitoring devices;

WHEREAS, for strengthening the monitoring and compliance through self-regulatory mechanism, online source emission and effluent monitoring systems need to be installed and operated by the industries on 'polluter pays principle';

WHEREAS, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs) for installation of online emission monitoring system w.r.t. PM and SO<sub>2</sub> parameters & online effluent monitoring system w.r.t. pH, BOD, COD and TSS in iron & steel industries;

WHEREAS, effluent parameters phenol and cyanide were added for online installation in iron and steel plants with by-product recovery type coke ovens;

WHEREAS, considering the requests/ representations received from industries/ industrial associations/ SPCBs / PCCs, an extension of time up to June 30, 2015 for installation of online monitoring systems was granted vide direction dated March 02,

2015 under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981;

WHEREAS, a letter vides dated May 29, 2015 was issued by the Chairman CPCB to all the SPCBs/ PCCs informing that no further extension of time will be given after June 30, 2015 and withdrawal of consent to operate along with forfeiture of bank guarantee of non-complying units;

WHEREAS, concerned SPCB/ PCC issued directions under section 33A of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and section 31A of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 to install the online monitoring system by June 30, 2015 and to submit bank guarantee of 100% of the cost of online emission & effluent monitoring system;

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof;

WHEREAS, Show Cause Notice under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986, was issued on July 23, 2015 to all integrated iron & steel plants and sponge iron units to show-cause as to why the unit should not be closed down if, the unit has not complied fully with the directions issued w.r.t. installation of online emission & effluent monitoring system by June 30, 2015. Further it was directed to submit documentary evidence regarding status of installation and connectivity;

WHEREAS, M/s. Ankit Metal & Power Ltd., Jorehira, Chhatna, Bankura, West Bengal had failed to install online monitoring system and provide 24x7 online connectivity to CPCB server for effluent and emission monitoring system till February 28, 2017. Therefore, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, M/s. Ankit Metal & Power Ltd., Jorehira, Chhatna, Bankura, West Bengal had been directed on 6.4.2017 to close down its operation with immediate effect due to non-compliance of the notice issued on July 23, 2015 and installation and providing 24x7 online connectivity to CPCB server for effluent and emission monitoring system as per guidelines of CPCB.

WHEREAS, a representation from the industry vide letter dated 16.08.2017 is received in response to aforesaid closure direction, wherein it is communicated that the unit has installed online monitoring system (OCEMS) and its connectivity with CPCB Server has been established. The response has been examined and it is noted that the connectivity of the OCEMS installed by the unit has been established with CPCB Server.

WHEREAS, unit was inspected by CPCB, RD- Kolkata on 18.08.2017 for SMS / offline related non-compliance and found non-compliant with source emission at 25 TPH boiler

(PM value – 139 mg/Nm<sup>3</sup>) along with other non-compliance and accordingly the unit was asked vide CPCB letter dated 12.10.2017 to complete the works of OCEMS installation.

WHEREAS, vide CPCB letter dated 22.11.2017 and email dated 23.11.2017 in which unit was asked to submit a suitability / adequacy report from Govt. Institution about ZLD as well as Emission Control System (ECS).


WHEREAS, vide unit letter dated 11.12.2017 submitted reply enclosing adequacy assessment report issued by CSIR-Central Institute of Mining & Fuel Research, Dhanbad, Jharkhand, which was placed before three-member committee meeting held on 19.12.2017 at CPCB, Delhi.

WHEREAS, a meeting of the committee for revocation of closure directions was held on 19.12.2017 at CPCB, Delhi and in view of above three-member committee recommended for revocation of closure order dated 06.04.2016 subjected to obtain and submission of Consent to Operate and submit emission / effluent quality analysis report from an Environment (P) Act, 1986 recognized laboratory within one month.

NOW, therefore in view of above, the closure direction dated April 06, 2017 issued u/s 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to M/s. Ankit Metal & Power Ltd., Jorehira, Chhatna, Bankura, West Bengal is hereby revoked with the following conditions:


1. The industry shall operate with valid consent under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, & Authorization under H&OW (M&TBM) Rules, 2016 and submit the same to CPCB within one month.
2. The unit shall submit emission / effluent quality analysis report from an Environment (P) Act, 1986 recognized laboratory within one month.
3. The industry shall not restart operation of the self-closed 25 TPH capacity AFBC/ CFPB boiler relevant stacks with immediate effect from date of issue of this letter and will complete the work and submit completion report. Further, WBPCB shall not renew the relevant stacks and process accordingly in its new CTO.
4. The industry shall ensure continuous data transmission from online emission and effluent monitoring systems to CPCB and SPCB.

However, any expansion of the existing project in future shall be intimated to CPCB/SPCB and applicability /scope of the installation of OCEMS will be subjected to further verification.
