Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 - Revoke reg.

WHEREAS, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Navratan Industries, located at Plot No. 70/59, 532, 533, 150ft. Road, Jajmau, Kanpur (hereafter referred as the Unit), is a tannery engaged in processing of raw hides to produce finished leather; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected by representatives of CPCB on 01.04.2017 and made the following observations:

- (i) The unit was operational on the day of visit.
- (ii) Housekeeping in the unit was poor.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB issued direction dated 23.05.2017 to the unit; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected by CPCB on 25.05.2017 and made the following observations:

- (i) The unit was operational on the day of visit.
- (ii) The unit utilizes about 71 m³/day of water with a waste water generation of 58 m³/day.
- (iii) The unit has consent under Water and Air Acts valid up to 31.12.2017. However, validity of hazardous waste authorization has expired on 11.6.2017.
- (iv) The industry has installed the Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS) and has provided the connectivity with CPCB server.
- (v) The PETP effluent quality depicted pH 3.52 (norms 6.5-9.0), TSS 345mg/l (norms 600mg/l) and Total Chromium (Cr) 2.0 mg/l (norms 2.0mg/l) which indicates the effluent quality not complying for the parameter of pH.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 23.08.2017 under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit for non-compliance; and

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WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters dated: 12.09.2017 & 21.12.2017 were examined and following observations are made-

- (i) The unit has submitted Self Certificate and provided OCEMS connectivity of flow meter.
- (ii) The unit has consent under Water Act & Air Act valid up to 31.12.2017.
- (iii) The unit has submitted undertaking in the CPCB prescribed format.
- (iv) The unit has submitted copy of the applied HWM authorization.
- (v) The unit has installed automatic air blower along automatic dosing pump with pH controllers in collection cum equalization tank and provided photographs of the same.

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three-member committee in its meeting held on 21.12.2017 examined the replies dated: 12.09.2017 & 21.12.2017 and recommended for the revoke of closure direction with the following conditions: -

- (i) The unit shall submit daily analysis report of ETP for one month from the date of resumption of manufacturing operation.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure direction dated 23.08.2017 is hereby revoked and the Unit M/s Navratan Industries, 532, 533, 150ft. Road, Jajmau, Kanpur is directed to comply with the following:

- (i) The Unit shall obtain the valid consent to operate from UPPCB and submit a copy to the CPCB.
- (ii) The Unit shall inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations.
- (iii) The Unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged by the Unit will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB / inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated into the CETP.
- (iv) The Unit shall maintain log book for hazardous waste/chromium sludge disposal.
- (v) The Unit shall submit analysis result of the treated effluent from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act 1986, within 30 days from the date of resumption of manufacturing operation.
- (vi) The unit shall submit daily treated effluent analysis report for one month from date of resumption of operation to CPCB.
- (vii) The unit shall discharge the effluent not more than the consented value (58 m³/day).

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
