Sub.: Direction issued under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986- reg.

WHEREAS, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Amar Brothers Global Pvt. Ltd., a tannery unit located at Rakba-60, Manpur, G.T. Road, Shivrajpur, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh, (here in after referred as the Unit) was inspected on 27.04.2017, by the team of officials deputed by CPCB and observed the following:

- 1) The Unit is a tannery plant and processes from wet blue hides to finished leather.
- 2) The Unit was operational but no production was found during the inspection.
- 3) The Unit has installed water meter and waste water flow meter to measure the actual discharge.
- 4) The Unit has installed online continuous effluent monitoring system (OCEMS) having connectivity with CPCB server.
- 5) Manufacturing process of the unit is Wet blue - Rechroming-Neutrilization-Retaining, Dyeing and fat liquoring.
- 6) The Unit did not provide the copy of consent under Water, Air Acts and authorization issued by UPPCB for hazardous waste generation / disposal.
- 7) Details on processing capacity, effluent discharge from unit, final mode of disposal of treated from ETP, ETP Capacity, location of TSDF for disposal of sludge from ETP, Quantity of waste generation were not provided to the inspection team.

AND WHEREAS, CBCB issued showcause notice dated 22.06.2017, under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; to the Unit, and

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WHEREAS, the unit was re-inspected by CPCB officials on 07.06.2017 and following observations were made:

- (i) On the day of visit, the unit and its PETP was found in operation.
- (ii) The unit has restarted its operation after revoking closure directions by CPCB and obtaining valid consent from UPPCB. However, copy of the same was not provided by the unit.
- (iii) The unit has installed ZLD based ETP and also installed online camera's and connected them with CPCB server.

WHEREAS, the unit replies vide their letters dated: 07.07.2017, 17.07.2017, 21.07.2017, 22.07.2017, 24.07.2017 and 18.08.2017 were examined and the following observations are made:

- (i) The Unit has consent under Water and Air Acts, valid up to 31.12.2018 as issued by UPPCB.
- (ii) As certified by CLRI, the electro-oxidation facility of the unit is working properly and is adequate in achieving zero wastewater discharge.
- (iii) The Unit has registered on CPCB portal and provided the connectivity with server.
- (iv) The Unit has submitted the copy of application for Hazardous waste authorization applied to UPPCB.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, the show cause notice dated 22.06.2017 is hereby revoked and M/s Amar Brothers Global Pvt. Ltd., Rakba-60, Manpur, G.T. Road, Shivrajpur, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh is directed to comply with the following:

- (i) The Unit shall submit the copy of valid Hazardous waste authorization to CPCB within 15 days of receipt from the UPPCB .
- (ii) The Unit shall submit analysis report of treated effluent before Electro-oxidation process, from laboratory recognised under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days.
- (iii) The Unit shall take necessary action to ensure the Zero effluent discharge as per the condition in the Consent to operate issued by UPPCB.

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
