Sub: Direction under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986- regarding

WHEREAS, Fertilizer units are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality;

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self-monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent and emission monitoring devices;

WHEREAS, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs) for installation of online emission monitoring system w.r.t. Urea Plants – PM, CAN/NPK/Ammonium Nitrite – PM, Ammonia, Fluoride, DAP plants – PM, Fluoride & SSP plants – PM, Fluoride parameters & online effluent monitoring system w.r.t. pH, Ammonical Nitrogen, Fluoride & Flow parameters in Fertilizer industries;

WHEREAS, a team of officers from the Regional Directorate, Central Pollution Control Board, Bhopal visited the unit **M/s Madhya Bharat Agro Product Ltd., Village Rajoua, Tehsil & District- Sagar, Madhya Pradesh** on 13.09.2017 & 14.09.2017 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures; and

WHEREAS, it was observed that the unit has not installed online continuous emission monitoring system for Particulate Matter (PM) parameter at SSP stack; and

WHEREAS, it was observed that unit has consent to operate valid up to May 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, fugitive emissions were observed around SSP loose godown area & SSP mill section area and it was also observed that internal roads were unpaved and caused fugitive emission; and

WHEREAS, it was observed that hazardous waste was not properly stored and silica sludge was observed overflowing from silica settling tank to ground; and

WHEREAS, it was observed that silica settling tank and waste water drain was damaged; and

WHEREAS, directions (notice) under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, notice was issued to the unit on November 28, 2017 to show

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cause why the unit shall not be directed to close down all operational activities with immediate effect until following directions are complied:

1. The unit shall install online continuous emission monitoring system for Particulate Matter (PM) parameter at SSP stack and provide its data connectivity to CPCB.
2. The unit shall obtain valid consent to operate granted by Madhya Pradesh Pollution Control Board.
3. The unit shall take necessary steps to prevent fugitive emissions around SSP loose godown area & SSP mill section area.
4. The unit shall make internal roads concreted / cemented.
5. The unit shall take adequate steps for proper storage of silica sludge and other hazardous waste as per Hazardous & other Waste (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
6. The unit shall repair damaged silica settling tank and waste water drain immediately.



WHEREAS, the unit submitted time bound point wise reply of the show cause notice vide email dated December 14, 2017 and has stated that installation of online continuous emission monitoring system for PM will be completed by 10.01.2018; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

NOW, THEREFORE, based on all facts and observations, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, **M/s Madhya Bharat Agro Product Ltd., Village Rajoua, Tehsil & District- Sagar, Madhya Pradesh** is hereby directed to comply with following direction:

1. The unit shall install online continuous emission monitoring system for Particulate Matter (PM) parameter at SSP stack and provide its data connectivity to CPCB by 10.01.2018.
2. The unit shall comply with other directions of the Show Cause Notice issued by Central Pollution Control Board on November 28, 2017.

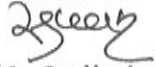
In case of failure to comply with the said directions necessary action as deemed fit under the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be taken by Central Pollution Control Board which includes criminal prosecution of the unit head and levying a penalty of environmental compensation.
