DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries have been identified as one the Grossly Polluting Industries (GPI) which have been discharging effluents directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on land and the ambient water quality; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to inculcate habit of self monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent and emission monitoring devices; and

WHEREAS, for strengthening the monitoring and compliance through self regulatory mechanism, online source emission and effluent monitoring systems need to be installed and operated by the industries on 'polluter pays principle'; and

WHEREAS, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & control of pollution) Act, 1974 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all 11 Ganga Basin State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs)/Pollution Control Committee (PCC) for installation of online effluent monitoring system w.r.t. pH, BOD, TSS, COD and flow parameters in Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries; and

WHEREAS, it was clarified that flow meter & web camera may be installed in case of units with Zero Liquid Discharge (ZLD) by March 31, 2015 vide guidelines uploaded on website of CPCB dated November 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, considering the requests/representations received from industries/industrial associations /SPCBs/PCCS, an extension of time up to June 30, 2015 for installation of online monitoring systems was granted vide direction dated March 27, 2015 under section 18 (1) (b) of Water (Prevention & control of pollution) Act, 1974; and

WHEREAS, a letter vide dated May 29, 2015 was issued to the Chairman CPCB to all the SPCBs/PCCS informing that no further extension of time will be given after June 30, 2015 and withdrawal of consents to operate along with forfeiture of bank guarantee of non-complying Units will be the only option; and

WHEREAS, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has issued directions from time to time regarding stopping of discharging of untreated effluent into Ganga vide its order dated 09.09.1985, 22.09.1987, 12.01.1988, 04.08.1992, 23.07.1993, 17.08.1993, 01.11.1995, 10.10.2006 and 29.10.2014 in the writ petition (Civil) no. 3727/1985 and also referred to the

direction of CPCB dated 05.02.2014 to identify all industrial units for appropriate measures for compliance of the points enumerated in the said order in a time bound manner with immediate effect; and

WHEREAS, M/s Aditya Kumar Yadav Rangai Karkhana Ambedkar Nagar, Farrukhabad, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is textile processing unit engaging in dyeing process; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by CPCB officials dated 16th October 2017 to verify the compliance. The following observations were made by the team:-

1. The unit was found operational at the time of inspection.
2. Name plate/sign board was not found at entrance of the unit. The unit was identified/located through enquiry to the local people of that area.
3. The unit is running without obtaining valid consent under Water Act and Air Act.
4. The unit has not installed effluent treatment plant for the treatment of trade effluent.
5. The unit was engaged in dyeing process at the time of inspection. The unit has a single Jigger (winch) in which process was going on.
6. At the time of inspection, no effluent was being discharged into the drain, therefore sample could not be collected.

AND WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions are being issued:

1. The Unit **M/s Aditya Kumar Yadav Rangai Karkhana Ambedkar Nagar, Farrukhabad, Uttar Pradesh** shall close down all the plant operations immediately.
2. The Unit shall report to CPCB regarding closure of manufacturing operations in compliance of the direction immediately on receipt of this direction.
7. The unit shall install adequate effluent treatment plant for the treatment of trade effluent.
3. The unit shall install the online effluent monitoring system and connect with CPCB server.
4. The Unit shall obtain valid consent from UPPCB under Air and Water Acts.
5. After completion of the above said measures, the unit shall report to CPCB and seek permission from CPCB before resumption of their manufacturing operations.

Failure to comply with above directions will attract action in accordance with the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
