DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries have been identified as one the Grossly Polluting Industries (GPI) which have been discharging effluents directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on land and the ambient water quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s N. S. India, Khatakpura, Siddiqui, Narkasha, Farrukhabad, U.P. (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is engaged in dyeing; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected by a team of CPCB officials on 16.10.2017 and the following observations are made:

1. No indication / sign board of the unit on the road.
2. Dyeing pots and washing pits has been installed for processing in the unit area.
3. Electricity connection of the unit is being acquired from the domestic connection of the adjacent house hold.
4. No effluent treatment facility is available at the unit and the waste water is directly discharged in to the sewer.
5. Status of consent could not be verified, as the unit did not provided copy of consent.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions are being issued to the unit for compliance:

- 1) The Unit (**M/s N. S. India, Khatakpura, Siddiqui, Narkasha, Farrukhabad, U.P.**) shall immediately close down all kind of manufacturing operations and inform to CPCB.

- 2) The unit shall install and commission adequate effluent treatment plant (ETP) to treat effluent so as to meet the effluent discharge standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.
 - 3) The unit shall install and provide connectivity of online continuous effluent monitoring system to the CPCB server.
 - 4) The unit shall obtain a valid consent to operate from the Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board.
 - 5) After completion of the above said measures, the Unit shall report to CPCB and seek permission from CPCB before resumption of any manufacturing operation.
- Failure to comply with above directions will attract action in accordance with the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
