**Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 –reg.**

**WHEREAS**, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, the CPCB issued show cause notice dated 13.06.2017 under Section 5 of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986 to the M/s ATO Exim (P) Ltd. B-13, 14 LTP, Banthar Unnao, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred to as the Unit); and

**WHEREAS**, the Unit reply vide letter dated 03.08.2017 was examined and following observations are made:

- (i) The unit has introduced dosing of Poly Aluminium Chloride with lime and alum and Anionic Poly Electrolyte to reduce TSS in the discharge to get TSS within the prescribed norms; and
- (ii) The unit has submitted effluent sample analysis report from recognized laboratory, indicating TSS value 469 mg/l, pH 7.8 and Total Chromium 1.32 mg/L.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, the Show cause notice dated 13.06.2017 is hereby revoked and the unit M/s ATO Exim (P.) Ltd., B-13, 14, LTP, Banthar, Unnao, Uttar Pradesh is directed to comply with the following:

- (i) The Unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged by the Unit will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB / inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated into the CETP.
- (ii) The Unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, within 30 days.
- (iii) The Unit shall obtain valid consent to operate under Water Act and Air Act and submit copies of consents to CPCB within 30 days, failing which, the unit will be closed on its own and inform CPCB.

In case of failure of the unit to comply with the directions, action will be taken in accordance with the provisions under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
