DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries have been identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging effluent directly on land and into water having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s. M.R. Proofing Industries (hereafter referred to as 'the unit') is a textile, dyeing industry located near Durga Dharam Kanta, Magarwara, Unnao, UP; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued show cause notice for closure dated 21.06.2016 under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to **M/s. MR Proofing Industries, Near Durga Dharam Kanta, Magarwara, Unnao, UP** to show cause why the unit should not be closed down if the Unit has not complied fully with the direction issued by CPCB in respect of GPI w.r.t installation of online continuous effluent monitoring system (OCEMS) by June 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected by a team of officials from IIT (BHU) on April 11, 2017 to verify the compliance status, the unit was found non-complying with the prescribed effluent discharge standards for BOD, TSS, Oil & Grease, Ammonical Nitrogen, Sulphide, Sodium Absorption Ration (SAR) and Total Dissolved Solid (TDS) in treated effluent posing injury to the environment; and has not installed online effluent monitoring system (OCEMS); and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction to the Unit vide letter dated June 20, 2017 for non-compliance of direction for installation of online effluent treatment system and non-compliance in effluent discharge standards norms; and

WHEREAS, the unit reply vide letter dated 22.11.2017 was examined and following observations are made:

1. The Unit has installed the OCEMS and connected with CPCB server
2. The Unit has submitted ETP modification report to achieve the standards of effluent discharge
3. An undertaking received separately regarding the compliance of all directions issued by CPCB and in case during verification by CPCB officials, if the Unit is found non-compliance the unit accept to close down the industry immediately and to not operate till full compliance is achieved.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

AND WHEREAS, the three member committee in its meeting held on 21.12.2017 examined the replies and reports of the Unit and recommended that the Unit may be allowed to resume operations and the unit shall submit report of analysis of effluent per day for one month from the date of resumption from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

AND WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue

directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions are issued for compliance to **M/s. MR Proofing Industries, Near Durga Dharam Kanta, Magarwara, Unnao, UP:**

- 1) The unit may resume manufacturing operations with immediate effect.
- 2) The unit shall immediately inform to CPCB regarding the resumption of operations.
- 3) The unit shall operate ETP properly so as to ensure with the effluent discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
- 4) The unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report per day, for one month from the date of resumption of operations, by the laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
- 5) The unit shall ensure continuous connectivity of OCEMS system installed at the outlet of ETP with CPCB server.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
