DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries have been identified as one the Grossly Polluting Industries (GPI) which have been discharging effluents directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on land and the ambient water quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s Praveen Textiles, E-4, Panki Industrial area Site 2, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is a Textile industry; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected on 05.04.2017 to verify the compliance status and was found non-complying w.r.t. OCEMS connectivity and treated effluent discharge standards; and

WHEREAS, the unit was issued closure direction dated 15.05.2017 under section 5 of the Environment Protection) Act, 1986 for OCEMS non-connectivity; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected on 21.06.2017 by CPCB officials and was found in operation in violation of CPCB closure direction; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 22.06.2017 under section 5 of the Environment Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit for noncompliance of effluent discharge standards and OCEMS non-connectivity w.r.t. inspection dated 05.04.2017; and

WHEREAS, the replies from the unit vide letters dated 01.08.2017, 17.08.2017, 01.11.2017 and 18.12.2017 were examined and following observations are made –

- i. The unit has provided undertaking and self certificate as per
- ii. format.
- iii. The unit has installed OCEMS (flow meter and web camera) and provided connectivity to CPCB server.
- iv. The unit does not possess valid consents to operate but has applied to the state pollution control board for a revised consent of 9 KLD of waste water.
- v. The unit has modified the ETP (evidenced by photographs).

AND WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 for examination of representations from the unit regarding recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the three member committee in its meeting held on 21.12.2017 examined the representations from the Unit and recommended that the Unit may be allowed to resume operation with revised waste water discharge capacity of 9 KLD; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the direction dated 22.06.2017 issued to the unit is hereby revoked and the unit is directed to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit **M/s Praveen Textiles, E-4, Panki Industrial area Site 2, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh** shall obtain valid consent to operate from state pollution control board with 9 KLD of industrial waste water discharge limit before resuming operation and shall inform the date of resumption of operation to CPCB.
2. The unit shall ensure uninterrupted connectivity of the OCEMS to the CPCB & SPCB server for treated effluent monitoring.
3. The Unit shall operate ETP properly so as to ensure compliance with the effluent discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. At any stage, if the treated effluent does not meet notified discharge standards the unit shall close down manufacturing operations immediately and report to CPCB.
4. The unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognised under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, within 30 days of resumption of manufacturing operations to CPCB.

Failure to comply with the above directions will attract action in accordance with the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 without any prior notice.
