Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, the tannery and leather industries are also identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly in to ambient Air and Water, having potential to threat to cause adverse effects on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s Pacific Leather Pvt. Ltd.,198/200 Gajjapurva, Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is a Tannery industry and was inspected by a team of officials authorized by CPCB on 4th April,2017 to verify the compliance status; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued Show Cause notice dated May 22nd, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit for the following:

- 1) To upgrade the primary ETP facilities and to operate /maintain the same scientifically so as the treated effluent characteristics meet the standards/limits prescribed in the consent order.
- 2) To submit the compliance report/action taken report for the above direction at point (i) within 15 days on receipt of this direction letter.

AND WHEREAS, the unit has replied vide letters dated 7th June, 2017 and 28th July,2017 in respect of the directions that:

- 1) The unit has installed various screens for the reduction of TSS.
- 2) The unit has also installed rotary filter on the inlet of primary ETP to remove grid and floating material.

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- 3) The unit is regularly monitoring automatic chemical dosing in dissolved air floatation (DAF) to ensure the exact quantity of chemical requirement to coagulate the fine particles by flocculation of the agglomeration of de established particles to take the form of large particles by adding Poly.
- 4) The unit has submitted undertaking for compliance of CPCB directions.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, Show Cause notice dated May 22nd, 2017 is hereby revoked and the unit, **M/s Pacific Leather Pvt. Ltd., 198/200 Gajjupurva, Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh** is directed to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit shall ensure proper operation of the ETP so as to achieve the prescribed standards and continuous transmission of data to CPCB server.

In case of non-compliance of the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit without giving any further notice in accordance with the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
