Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 –reg.

WHEREAS, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Qaiyum Leather, 16 C-2, 150 Feet Road, Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh (here in after referred as the Unit), was inspected by CPCB officials on 01.04.2017 and following observation were made:

- (i) The unit was operating without Chrome Recovery Plant (CRP).
- (ii) The analysis of sample collected from PETP outlet showed pH 7.5 (against norms 6.5-9.0), Cr 0.658 PPM (against norms 2 PPM) and TSS 660 PPM (against norms 600 PPM) which indicates non-compliance with the prescribed effluent discharge norms w.r.t. TSS under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the CPCB issued show cause notice dated 23.05.2017 under Section 5 of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986 to the M/s Qaiyum Leather, 16 C-2, 150 Feet Road, Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh, (herein after referred as the Unit); and

WHEREAS, the Unit reply vide letters dated 30.05.2017 and 14.06.2017 was examined and following observations are made:

- (i) The Unit has informed that they have CRP since the last twenty years.
- (ii) The Unit has taken extra precaution by installing a few more fine screens to minimise the TSS.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, the Show cause notice dated 23.05.2017 is hereby revoked and the unit M/s Qaiyum Leather, 16 C-2, 150 Feet Road, Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh is directed to comply with the following:

- (i) The Unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged by the Unit will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB / inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated into the CETP.
- (ii) The Unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, within 30 days.

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- (iii) The Unit shall obtain valid consent to operate under Water Act and Air Act and submit copies of consents to CPCB within 30 days, failing which, the unit will be closed on its own and inform to CPCB.
- (iv) The Unit shall submit the copy of valid Hazardous waste authorization to CPCB within 15 days of receipt from the UPPCB.

In case of failure of the unit to comply with the directions, action will be taken in accordance with the provisions under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
