DIRECTIONS UNDER SECTION 5 OF ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge³ of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any local body or any other authority for violations of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

WHEREAS, M/s. Bee Kay Woollens (P) Ltd, Gyanpur Road, District- Bhadohi, UP (hereinafter referred as 'the Unit') is involved in the Textile processing of wool and silk yarn dyeing using grey wool yarn /cotton yarn and dyer & chemicals as main raw material; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued show cause notice for closure dated 21.06.2016 to the unit under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit; and

WHEREAS, unit was inspected by the officials of CPCB on March 21, 2017 to verify the compliance status and observed the following

- i. Non-installation of OCEMS system;
- ii. No proper operation of ETP (made operational after team reached the Unit premises);
- iii. No valid authorization under the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rule, 2016 from UPPCB;
- iv. Treated effluent analysis from the ETP found to have Phenol-1.96 mg/l (as against 1 mg/l) which indicates non-compliance with the prescribed effluent discharge norms under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986;
- v. Unit has not obtained permission from Central Ground Water Authority for extraction of groundwater;
- vi. Non installation of mechanical sludge de-watering system for ETP sludge;
- vii. All sludge drying beds were found empty and in damaged condition

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 22.05.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit, (M/s. Bee Kay Woollens (P) Ltd, Gyanpur Road, District- Bhadohi, UP), to close down its manufacturing operations till compliance to the notified effluent discharge standards under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and installation & commissioning online continuous emission monitoring system (OCEMS) along with providing connectivity for submission of online 24*7 monitoring data to UPPCB and CPCB server; and

WHEREAS, the unit has submitted reply vide letters dated 20.06.2017, 04.08.2017 and 02.12.2017 which were examined and following observations are made:

1. The Unit has updated ETP, provided the details of ETP unit components and provided undertaking regarding completion of installation of revised ETP.
2. Unit has provided copy of application for permission to abstract ground water for industrial use made to Central Ground Water Authority.
3. Unit has provided copy of authorization under the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rule, 2016 from UPPCB.
4. Unit has provided copy of consent to operate under Water and Air Act from UPPCB which is valid upto December 31, 2017.
5. The Unit has installed OCEMS and provided connectivity to CPCB server.
6. The Unit has requested for revoke of closure direction issued by CPCB to start their operation.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

AND WHEREAS, the three member committee in its meeting held on 21.12.2017 examined the replies and reports of the Unit and recommended that the Unit may be allowed to resume operations and the unit shall submit report of analysis of effluent for one month from the date of assumption from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

AND WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions are issued for compliance to to M/s. Bee Kay Woollens (P) Ltd, Gyanpur Road, District- Bhadohi, UP:

- 1) The Unit may resume manufacturing operations with immediate effect.
- 2) The Unit shall immediately inform to CPCB regarding the resumption of operations.
- 3) The Unit shall operate ETP properly so as to ensure with the effluent discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
- 4) The Unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report to CPCB for one month from the date of resumption of operations, by a laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
- 5) The Unit shall ensure continuous connectivity of OCEMS system installed at the outlet of ETP with CPCB server.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
